Bike Coalition Report

Paul and David reported that the Grand Opening of the Pershing Bikeway will be on July 27, 2024.

The Convoy Street bikeway in Kearny Mesa has brought criticism from local businesses due to the loss of 288 parking spaces along Convoy St. The San Diego County Bicycle Coalition supports both new bikeways.

David reported that the agenda for the upcoming Advocacy Committee meeting includes a discussion of standards for flexible posts (bollards?) on bikeways. Although Paul believes that best practices for bikeways would not include flexible posts, if they are used, they should either have beveled bases or no base and be widely spaced. CVs are encouraged to attend the Advocacy Committee meeting.
