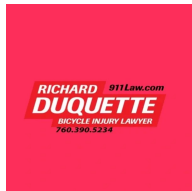

Discussion of Ride the Point (RTP) and the 2025 Cyclo-vet luncheon were moved to the start of meeting to allow Richard and Julie to participate prior to them leaving the meeting for other appointments. Richard presented a history of Ride the Point, a bicycle ride and fund raiser for pancreatic cancer research. The ride was started eleven years ago by the Point Loma Rotary Club (PLRC) in memory of Jim Krause, a PLRC member and a Cyclo-vet. All profits from the event are given to researchers at UCSD as seed money for basic research. There has been a close association with RTP and Cyclo-vets since the event's beginning, with the club donating money and Cyclo-vets participating in the event as volunteer ride marshalls. Following the presentation, there was discussion about making a donation for 2025. Julie suggested a

donation of \$3500. Jean made a motion to donate \$3500 and Mary Jo seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

This year's club luncheon will be held at the Eureka Restaurant on August 9 from 11:00AM until 2:00 PM. A motion was made and seconded to allocate \$200 for gift cards for the raffle. The motion was passed unanimously.

Approval of Minutes - Jean

Bruce made a motion to approve the minutes from the May BOD meeting. Nancee seconded the motion and it was passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report - Steve

There was no new income for June. The balance of the account on 6/30/2025 was 17,358.36

Membership Report - Nancee

As of July 14, the club has 70 members. In the past month there have been two members added, one new member and one renewal.

Sponsorship Report - David

Ride the Point has become a sponsor and has donated \$1000.

Bike Advocate Report - Paul

Paul reported that he believes the **California Coalition of Bicycle Clubs (CABO)** is a valuable organization that advocates for and represents interests of most Cyclo-vets. Paul made a motion that the club renew its membership in CABO. Bruce seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Zoom Authorization - David

David reported that he is having difficulty making changes to the club's zoom account. The original zoom account was set up using the club's website. That website was poached and changes were made to the account, including the email address. Rather than pay to get the website back, the club created a new website. Since the zoom account is associated with the old website and, the poacher changed the email address on that account, David cannot make changes and would like to create a new account. David would like the Board to authorize setting up a new account. Don made a motion to authorize money, not to exceed \$200, to set up a new zoom account. Bruce seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Clothing Report - Rob

Rob reported that he has been having difficulty doing business with Zoca since Karla left last summer. Sebastian does not return calls or emails and he is not open to meet in person. Rob reported that other clubs in the area have been using Eliel. This could be an option if the club decides to select a local business. Eliel is located in North SD County. A committee was created to explore options for next year's club clothing. MJ will chair the committee. Heather Woodruff has expressed an interest in being on the committee. Jean, Paul and Rob would like to be on the committee.

Nomination Committee for 2026 club officers

MJ will chair the committee. David will email position responsibilities to Board members.

Gordy Ride Recap - David

There were 50 riders. The weather report indicated a chance for rain but there was no rain on the day of the event. An organized run at the same time created delays for those riders who elected to circle the bay and return using the ferry. There were no other issues reported.

Club member Darryl Mackenzie has suggested a display at our club luncheon and purchase of new swag for club members. Don suggested t-shirts. Bruce reported that his brother may have input on purchasing swag. He offered to speak with his brother.
