Abundance Turned Affluenza

- Affluenza is a combination of the words affluence and influenza, coined in the 1950s as a somewhat humorous description of the children of inherited wealth.
- Affluenza has been defined as a:
 - 1. SOCIAL CONDITION that arises from the desire to be more wealthy or successful.
 - 2. GLOBAL PLAGUE of a state of loneliness, endless working hours, family conflict, rising debt, environmental pollution, and rampant commercialism.
 - 3. PAINFUL, CONTAGIOUS, SOCIALLY TRANSMITTED CONDITION of overload, debt, anxiety, and waste, resulting from the dogged pursuit of more.
 - 4. INABILITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL TO UNDERSTAND THE CONSEQUENCES OF THEIR ACTIONS because of their social status or economic privilege.
 - 5. STATE OF CONFUSION, leaving a person unable to tell right from wrong because of wealth.
 - 6. PSYCHOLOGICAL MALAISE affecting wealthy young people, including lack of motivation, feelings of guilt, and a sense of isolation.
 - 7. DENIAL, DISCONNECTION & DISINTEREST in working to improve and regulate their emotions, thinking, behaviors, and relationships as long as the money keeps flowing.


BETTER WAYS TO MEASURE SUCCESS





WORLD PROGRESS - REVIEW



- 1. The World Wisdom & Wellbeing Report for 2023 measures the progress of Humanity, Nature, and Peace.
- 2. Many organizations host meeting after meeting, conference after conference, year after year, and even decade after decade, often focusing on membership, dues, fundraising, and galas, with *no systemic and structural change* politically for Wisocracy, and economically for Wellbeing.
- 3. They make themselves look and sound good by attending meeting after meeting, and conference after conference, but they're not getting anything done globally for systemic and structural change.
- 4. The 10 million nonprofit and nongovernmental organizations don't collaborate for systemic and structural change.
- 5. We are struggling to contain:
 - The Military Industrial Surveillance Espionage COMPLEX
 - The Conflict Politics Fund Raising Publicity Social Media Podcast Pundits
 Media Profit on Conflict COMPLEX
 - The Fossil Fuel Corporatocracy
- 6. They are all causing local, national, and world conflict.

WORLD PROGRESS - REVIEW



- 7. There are many obstructionists, authoritarians, and now fascists growing on Earth who support repression and war and are against the environment.
- 8. People are stuck in their silos and paradigms.
- 9. People are politically obstructing each other's agendas.
- 10. People just continue doing what they are doing, with the system not changing.
- 11. When people work alone, they don't brainstorm to generate creative, new ideas.
- 12. When they don't meditate, they don't access their higher-creative-wiser mind.

WORLD PROGRESS - REVIEW




- 14. Groups actively working for a Protopian world (highly conscious, compassionate, and creative) are probably much less than 1% of the global population.
 - 100% = 8,000,000,000
 - 10% = 800,000,000
 - 1% = 8,000,000
- 15. As we are heading for extinction, there are probably 2 billion supporters for world wisdom, wellbeing economy, peace, and nature, but they do not collaborate.
- 16. There are also 2 billion "comfortably successful" people worldwide, not doing anything to help the world.
- 17. Presently they focus on sports and entertainment.
- 18. They are wasting their brains just when the planet needs them.
- 19. They need to activate their brains to look for solutions.
- 20. They can be brought into the process to create local and global Evolutionary Learning Groups where they can research solutions, and propose policy and legislation to local, regional, and national elected officials.

WORLD PROGRESS - RECOMMENDATIONS



- 1. We need to help humans evolve to be more conscious, collaborative, and creative to then get to the goals for peace and nature.
- 2. Individuals and organizations need to collaborate.
- 3. The Wisdom & Wellbeing Teams (Evolutionary Learning Groups) can meet frequently on Zoom, meditate and brainstorm with each other to produce breakthrough ideas.

- 4. We need to develop smart electric systems, renewable energy, mass transportation, and end fossil fuel use.
- 5. We can support Divestment from Weapons, War, and Carbon Fuel.
- 6. We can support *Investment in Human, Social, and Earth Wellbeing* a peaceful, green, sharing, and caring economy.
