Dear Friend of Earth & Humanity

In March of 2023, I met with four people in a Zoom meeting to explore the possibility of global government.

I had seen that Earth was headed for world destruction as the United States, China, and Russia were preparing for world war.

The United Nations had become highly ineffective because the General Assembly, by design, could not pass enforceable legislation, and the Security Council continued to veto peace proposals.

We needed positive leaders who are humble, egoless, wise, compassionate, and collaborative, and we needed a People's Government for Earth & Humanity. I researched the history of the idea of World Federalism and Global Parliament.

The following pages track development of those movements toward a world government.

At the end of this document, there is a page on political tracks/silos, and also one on world demographics and economic status.

The idea of discussing world government is not a *popular* topic at this time and may not be possible for a few more generations until a world population has adopted a planetary perspective.



- A United Nations Parliamentary Assembly (UNPA) is a proposed addition to the United Nations System that would allow for greater participation and voice for members of parliament.
- The idea was raised at the founding of the <u>League of Nations</u> in the 1920s and again following the end of World War II in 1945, but remained dormant throughout the <u>Cold War</u>.
 - The <u>Campaign for a United Nations Parliamentary Assembly</u> (CUNPA) was formed in 2007 by <u>Democracy Without Borders</u> (formerly Committee for a Democratic U.N.) to coordinate pro-UNPA efforts, which as of June 2017 has received the support of over 1,600 <u>members of parliament</u> from over 100 countries worldwide.
 - The <u>Commission on Global Security</u>, <u>Justice and Governance</u>, chaired by former U.S. Secretary of State <u>Madeleine Albright</u> and former Nigerian Foreign Minister <u>Ibrahim Gambari</u>, has called for the creation of a United Nations Parliamentary Network "to raise greater awareness and participation by strengthening the voices of legislators in global institutions."

- The commission proposes that this Network "would be similar in initial composition to the Parliamentary Network on the World Bank and International Monetary Fund and the Parliamentary Conference on the World Trade Organization".
- In July 2018, the <u>European Parliament</u> adopted a recommendation to the <u>European Council</u> endorsing a proposal for the establishment of a United Nations Parliamentary Assembly.
- Supporters have set forth possible UNPA implementations, including promulgation of a new treaty; creation of a UNPA as a subsidiary body of the UN General Assembly; and evolution of a UNPA from the <u>Inter-Parliamentary Union</u> or another <u>non-governmental organization</u>.
 - Several proposals for apportionment of votes have been raised to address disparities in population and economic power of UN members.
- **CUNPA** advocates initially giving the UNPA advisory powers and gradually increasing its authority over the UN system.

People's Assembly / Parliamentary Assembly

Suppose that after many years the General Assembly is persuaded to add a **People's Assembly** or **People's Chamber to help the General Assembly** "perform its functions," and that the people of the world, after further years of organizing, are finally able to elect their delegates to this **People's Assembly**. What is accomplished?

- Such a People's Assembly will not change the decision-making powers or processes of the General Assembly;
- The added People's Assembly could not enact world legislation nor assist the General Assembly or the Security Council to enact enforceable World Legislation on any issue whatsoever;
- The People's Assembly will not change the voting procedure in the General Assembly, which will remain at one vote per member nation, as directed by National Governments;
- The People's Assembly will not alter the "veto" power of each permanent Member of the Security Council, which will continue as the deciding power in the U.N.
- In short, the People's Assembly, if finally accomplished, would only be able to make studies, pass resolutions, and make recommendations to the General Assembly, to assist the General Assembly in the "performance of its functions." That is to say, the People's Assembly could only help the General Assembly do nothing for the practical solution of world problems.

People's Assembly / Parliamentary Assembly

The reason that an organized attempt to get a People's Assembly added to the General Assembly under Article 22 is worse than useless, is that such an attempt diverts the attention and energies and money of well-intentioned people away from what truly needs to be accomplished, which is the replacement of the U.N. entirely by a well-designed Constitution for Federal World Government.

During the process of trying to achieve a People's Assembly, good people are deluded into thinking they are accomplishing something of value and use in solving world problems, when they are at best accomplishing nothing of legislative or governing substance.

ADD A PARLIAMENTARY ASSEMBLY

During the last two years, a further proposal has gained popularity, which is to add a "Parliamentary Assembly" to the General Assembly of the U.N., also under the permissive paragraph of Article 22 of the Charter.

The proposal is for the National Parliaments of the Members nations to choose and send delegates to the Parliamentary Assembly added to help the General Assembly "perform its functions."

The same criticisms made concerning the proposal for adding a People's Assembly apply equally to the proposal for adding a Parliamentary Assembly.



Through the "Future of Global Governance" project, Atlas will work to design, build, and launch such a democratic, people-led transnational governance system to unite humankind beyond national borders and truly be One.


