1. Autocrats and Militarists' obsession with Power and War, and Oligarchs and Corporatists' obsession with Money and Greed is a distraction from their personal insecurities and fears they will be **future failed fossil fuel and military states**.
2. These dysfunctional leaders probably experienced **trauma in childhood, teen life, or as adults**, and are suffering from what could be called **Affection Deficit Disorder** or **Emotional Deprivation Schema** and may have **low emotional intelligence skills, lacking empathy** for self, others, and nature.
3. Under their leadership, Russia, China, India, Iran, North Korea, the US, and other countries are heading to becoming failed states because they cannot balance their economies, population, and environment.
4. They experience more conflict, corruption, and crime, and depend on **a police state** to contain populations growing in obsessions and traumas, self-absorption, and social conflict.
5. They are all using their obsessions with money, power, and military might to distract themselves from the reality that they have no future unless they **radically redesign their politics and economies** to be part of a **sustainable, peaceful planet** based on wisdom (political Wisocracy) and wellbeing (Doughnut Economics & Wellbeing Economy).

Maedeh Afrawi, 19

Iran

Afrawi joined the Iran uprising that occurred after the death of Mahsa Amini in police custody in September. She was arrested in November and is in pretrial detention on a charge of "participation in a public gathering."



Adam Sauko, 20

Belarus

Sauko was detained Nov. 9, 2021, and charged with organizing actions that "grossly violate public order." He was sentenced to five years in prison.



Viktar Dzibrou, 26

Belarus

Dzibrou was detained in August, initially charged with "insulting the president," and later prosecuted for "promoting extremist activities." He was sentenced to two-and-a-half years in prison.



Marfa Rabkova, 28

Belarus

Rabkova is a human rights defender for Viasna, a Belarusian human rights organization, charged with "organizing, participating in and training others to participate in mass riots," "inciting social hostility towards the government" and

Jailed for speaking out...



Darya Losik, 31

Belarus

After a TV interview in which Losik, the wife of jailed Ihar Losik, criticized the authorities and insisted her husband was not a criminal, she was arrested on Oct. 18 and charged with "facilitating extremism." She was sentenced to two years in prison.



Katsiaryna Khulkhacheva, 31

Belarus

Khulkhacheva was arrested on Sept. 29, 2021, and charged with "insulting the president," "insulting a government official" and "incitement to hatred" in an online post. She is still in pretrial detention.



Alberto García Scull, 34

Cuba

Scull, who participated in the July 11, 2022, protests, the largest in Cuba in decades, was sentenced to 18 months in prison on charges of "contempt," "public disorder" and perpetrating an "insult to the symbols of the homeland."



Moataz Hasbelnaby

Egypt

Hasbelnaby posted a selfie with a sign saying "Free Moka," showing support for his friend imprisoned at the time. He was arrested July 21, 2021, and put in the same cell as his friend, who was then released. Moataz remains imprisoned.

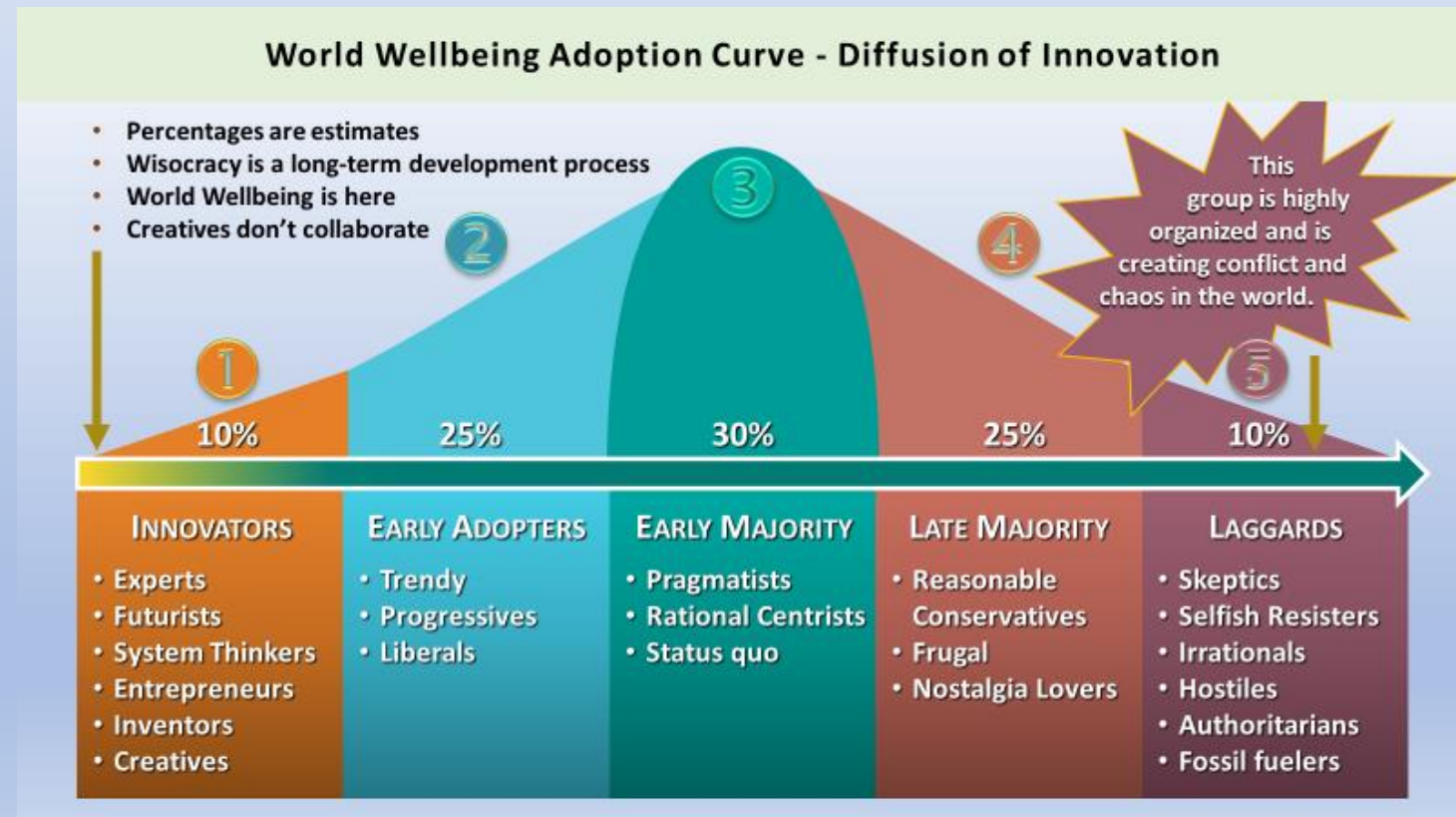

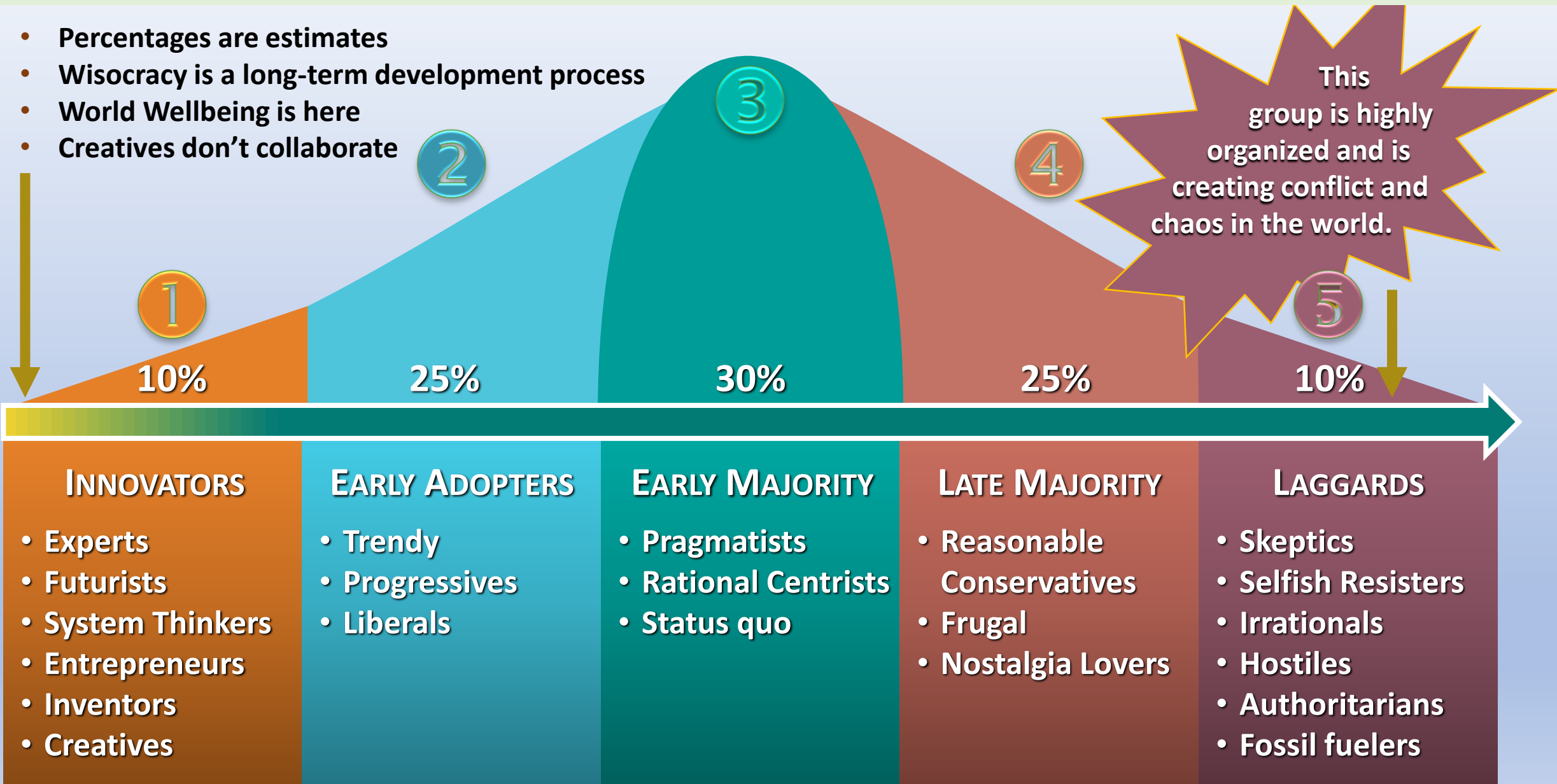

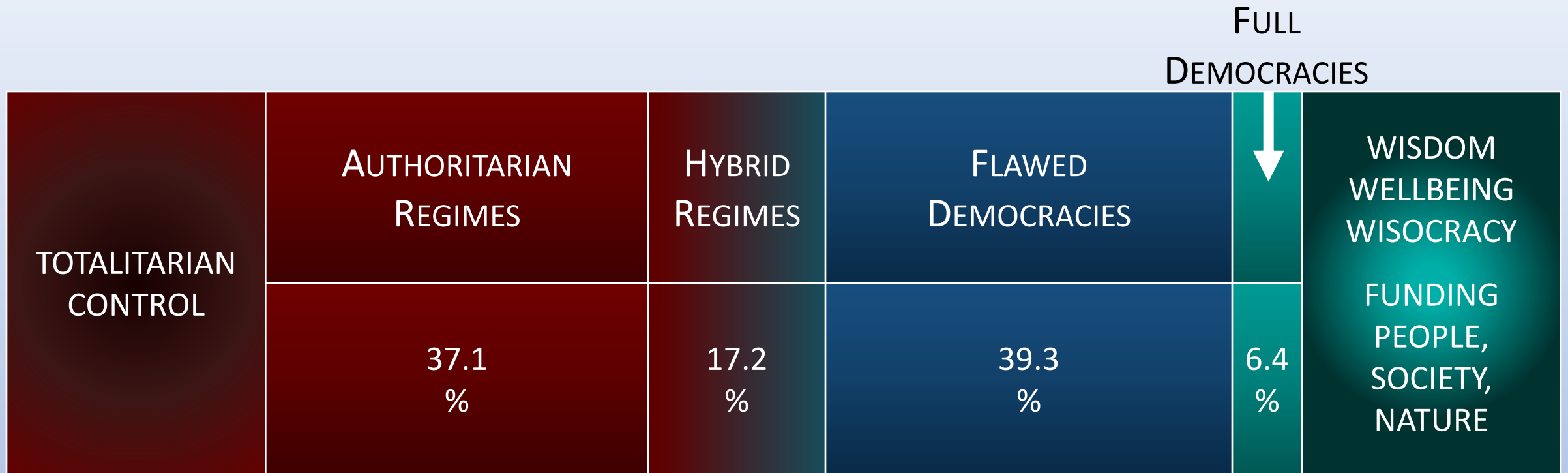
