Wisocracy stands against:

1. **AI without wisdom** — we oppose artificial superintelligence that lacks moral grounding, humility, or ecological awareness.
2. **The military–industrial–technological–academic complex** — a system that fuses power, profit, and prestige while disconnecting from human and planetary wellbeing.
3. **The ever-expanding wealth gap** — an economic failure that fuels despair, social decay, and violence.
4. **The marketing of arrogance, luxury, and status** — a cultural disease that replaces humility and contribution with vanity and consumption.
5. **Radical, sweeping queer or gender agendas** — not because we oppose human dignity, but because we believe identity should not be politicized, commercialized, imposed as ideology, or aggressively marketed. We support respect for all people, but reject ideological extremism that erases balance, biology, or shared human wisdom.

1. **Wise technology** guided by **ethics, empathy, and sustainability**.
2. **Global demilitarization to provide funding for Human Care, Social Care, and Earth Care.**
3. **Regenerative economics and Earth stewardship for health planetary boundaries.**
4. **Modesty, authenticity, and mutual respect** over performance and dominance.
5. **Human dignity for all, rooted in balance and compassion.**
