RANGE RULES

IN LOBBY AREA

FOR YOUR SAFETY & THOSE AROUND YOU, ONLY RANGE STAFF WILL CLEAR THE FIREARMS AT CHECKIN.

ALWAYS ASSUME ALL FIREARMS ARE LOADED AND HANDLE THEM ACCORDINGLY

ALWAYS POINT THE MUZZLE IN A SAFE DIRECTION SO THAT ANY ACCIDENTAL OR NEGLIGENT DISCHARGE WOULD NOT RESULT IN INJURY OR DEATH

ALWAYS KEEP FINGER OFF TRIGGER & OUT OF TRIGGER GUARD

- FIREARMS BROUGHT INTO THE BUILDING MUST BE UNLOADED. IF FIREARM IS NOT IN A CASE OR CONTAINER, ACTION MUST BE LOCKED OPEN. ALL FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION WILL BE INSPECTED BY RANGE OFFICERS. ONLY AUTHORIZED FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION MAY BE USED.
- DRY FIRING IS ALLOWED ON THE FIRING LINE ONLY. DRY FIRING IN THE LOBBY OR BEHIND THE FIRING LINE IS PROHIBITED
- NEVER SHOOT FROM THE HIP OR "BUMP FIRE" A FIREARM.
- NO FOOD, DRINKS, OR SMOKING ON THE RANGE.
- DRAWING FROM HOLSTER OR SIMULATED DRAWING FROM HOLSTER IS NOT PERMITTED. NO HOLSTERED FIREARMS ARE ALLOWED ON THE RANGE AT ANY TIME WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION.
- ANY ROUND TRAVELING OVER 1500 FEET PER SECOND IS PROHIBITED. NO ARMOR PIERCING, STEEL CORE, INCENDIARY, OR TRACER AMMUNITION. NO SHOTSHELLS – PERIOD.
- NO STEEL JACKET, BRASS JACKET, SEMI JACKETED, EXPOSED LEAD, OR SOFT POINT BULLETS ALLOWED. <u>FULL METAL JACKET OR JACKETED HOLLOW POINT</u> <u>ONLY</u>!!
- RANGE OFFICERS WILL BAR ANYONE HANDLING A GUN IN AN UNSAFE MANNER.
- PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN ON AND OFF THE RANGE AT ALL TIMES.
- EVERYONE MUST WEAR EYE AND HEARING PROTECTION WHILE ON THE RANGE. NO MORE THAN TWO SHOOTERS ALLOWED ON A LANE WITHOUT RANGE OFFICER APPROVAL.

- NO RIFLES. NO RIFLE CALIBER HANDGUNS. NO BLACK POWDER.
- KEEP FIREARMS POINTED TOWARD BACKSTOP AT ALL TIMES.
- LOAD AND UNLOAD AT SHOOTING BOOTH ONLY. HANDLE ALL FIREARMS, MAZAGINES AND AMMUNITION IN BOOTH ONLY.
- DO NOT BRING ANY LOADED OR JAMMED FIREARMS OFF THE RANGE FOR ANY REASON. IF THERE IS A PROBLEM, LAY THE GUN IN THE BOOTH AND NOTIFY RANGE OFFICER.
- DO NOT EXCHANGE FIREARMS WITH ANOTHER LANE. SWITCH SHOOTERS NOT GUNS.
- CEASE FIRE: ON THIS COMMAND UNLOADED, OPEN ACTION, LAY GUN DOWN, AND STEP BACK FROM THE LINE.
- OPEN ONLY ONE DOOR AT A TIME WHEN ENTERING OR LEAVING THE RANGE. LET THE DOOR CLOSE BEHIND YOU BEFORE PROCEEDING THROUGH THE NEXT ONE.
- YOU MAY REMOVE YOUR BRASS ONLY. ALL OTHER BRASS IS THE PROPERTY OF SHOOTHOUSE USA AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO LEAVE THE RANGE. NO BRASS MAY BE RETRIEVED FROM IN FRONT OF FIRING LINE.
- NO PREGNANT WOMEN ALLOWED ON THE RANGE.
- RANGE OFFICERS WILL BAR ANYONE BELIEVED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS OR ALCOHOL.
- FLASHING OF RANGE LIGHTS INDICATES A CEASE FIRE: ON THIS COMMAND, UNLOAD YOUR WEAPON; OPEN ACTION, LAY WEAPON DOWN AND STEP BACK FROM THE LINE. DO NOT MOVE BACK INTO THE BOOTH FOR ANY REASON UNTIL CLEARED TO DO SO BY A RANGE OFFICER.
- ANY PERSON WITH A MEDICAL DISORDER WHICH MIGHT CREATE A SAFETY HAZARD MUST NOTIFY RANGE OFFICERS BEFORE GOING OUT ONTO THE RANGE.
- DO NOT THROW ANY AMMUNITION OR EMPTY SHELLS INTO THE TRASH CONTAINERS. PLEASE THROW USED TARGETS, PAPER, & PLASTIC GARBAGE INTO TRASH CONTAINERS. SWEEP BRASS IN FRONT OF FIRING LINE.
- DESTROYING TARGET CLIPS WILL RESULT IN A \$2.00 CHARGE PER DAMAGE

ATTENTION NON-MEMBERS

- WHEN WE ARE BUSY, MEMBERS HAVE PRIORITY ON WAITING LIST
- IF THERE'S NO WAITING WE'RE NOT WATCHING THE CLOCK. IF WE HAVE MORE SHOOTERS THAN LANES NON-MEMBERS MAY BE RESTRICTED TO ONE HOUR OF SHOOTING, THE. FEE IS STILL GOOD FOR ALL DAY AND SHOOTER MAY WAIT FOR ANOTHER LANE TO FREE UP OR RETRUN ANYTIME THAT DAY.
