RE: SIG Sauer P320 and its variants

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

Shoothouse USA has always placed the safety of our members, guests and staff as paramount.

There has been a great deal of conversation surrounding the SIG Sauer P320 and its variants. After much consideration we are implementing the following rules on the P320 platform. The protocol detailed below will remain in effect unless and until a resolution is reached by SIG.

Effective immediately, all SIG Sauer P320 and its variants will be required to have slide locked back and magazine out of the firearm until such time as the member, guest, or student (referred to hereon as "customer") is HOLDING the firearm with muzzle oriented downrange before the magazine is inserted and slide released. If at anytime during that activity the customer intends stops shooting the magazine MUST be ejected AND slide placed in locked back position BEFORE the customer releases the firearm from their grip.

When the customer has completed their shooting session, the firearm must be in a slide lock, magazine out status before securing the firearm and exiting the shooting booth. If the customer is uncertain about the condition of the firearm, it should be left in the slide lock, magazine out position and left in the shooting stall, muzzle oriented downrange and seek Shoothouse range staff for assistance.
