Welcome you to Warmley Rangers FC and our home in Oldland Common at SBL / Redfield Edge Playing Fields. We have put together this information pack with the aim of helping you by supplying all the information you, your players and their parents need. Please contact your equivalent Warmley age group manager before you arrive as normal to ensure you are made aware of any changes.

### **Dogs**

We operate a strict **No dogs policy** at Warmley Rangers as the fields that we use are the property of the Wellsway Trust who operate this policy at all their school premises.

This is really important, as it is a condition of our lease.

Anyone bringing a dog onsite will be asked to remove it no matter how far they have travelled, so please make sure your parents know this.

### **Respect**

All games will be played under normal FA rules. Each pitch will have a respect barrier and all spectators must not pass beyond this to the side of the pitch.

Parents of your players are your responsibility, and their behaviour should reflect the Respect principles of the FA and you as a manager. Warmley Rangers will not accept any abuse of Referees, players or coaching staff and will report any incidents to the league and or FA.

**Please be respectful of our neighbours when using our facilities.**

### **Clubhouse**

At the clubhouse we have a licensed bar, along with hot and cold drinks, sweets and snacks. We also have sausage and bacon baps available at very reasonable prices. Contactless payment is available in the clubhouse bar which also has 3 TV screens showing football.

Note: The clubhouse is a member's bar and all visitors must sign the visitors' book to use the facility.

Note: Our license means that no alcohol can be consumed by the pitches. Alcoholic drinks cannot be taken beyond the clubhouse patio.

### **Litter**

We have a "Keep Warmley Green" programme of work to ensure that the fields used for games are the best they can be for playing football. There are rubbish bins in the car park and around the fields, so please clear up after your team. If you are in doubt about what to do with your rubbish, please ask the Warmley manager.

### **Toilets**

Toilets are in the car park in between the changing rooms and clubhouse. All toilets will be checked regularly by Warmley Rangers staff.

### **First Aid**

It is expected that all teams bring their 1<sup>st</sup> aid kits with them as per FA regulations, however, should any equipment be needed, or an ambulance need to be called please contact the clubhouse.

### **Defib**

We have a defib onsite which is located on the side of the clubhouse within a locked cabinet. If you need the code, please follow the instructions or contact a member of the clubhouse staff.
