We would like to welcome you to Warmley Rangers FC and our home in Oldland Common at SBL / Redfield Edge Playing Fields. We have put together this information pack with the aim of helping you by supplying all the information you, your players and their parents need. However please do contact your equivalent Warmley age group manager before you arrive as normal to ensure you are made aware of any changes.

COVID 19 Measures

All games held at Redfield Edge adhere to the government guidance around social distancing, plus the more specific guidance from the Football Association as child & spectator safety is our main priority. Sanitising equipment will be available on entry/exit to the playing fields, beside pitches and inside toilets. One-way systems will also be used around the Clubhouse and Car park. Our Test & Trace QR code is also available for scanning on all the sanitising stations and in the clubhouse.

Risk Assessment

A full FA recommended risk assessment has been completed and can be made available on request. It is updated in line with latest government advice.

Administration

Please make every effort to ensure you and your parents scan our QR code and sanitise upon arrival at Warmley Rangers. Dogs

We operate a strict **No dogs are allowed policy** at Warmley Rangers as the fields that we use are the property of the Wellsway Trust who operate this policy at all their school premises. Signs stating this can be seen in the entrances to both fields.

Note: Anyone bringing a dog onsite will be asked to remove it no matter how far they have travelled So please make sure your parents know this.

Games/Pitches & Parents behaviour

All games will be played under normal FA rules. Each pitch will have a respect barrier and all spectators must not pass beyond this to the side of the pitch. Social Distancing of everyone attending matches is mandatory.

Redfield Edge playing fields are large enough to enable everyone in attendance to social distance during games and breaks in play when other teams are playing. Please ensure that your team and any spectators follow government guidance and stay safe.

Parents of your players are your responsibility, and their behaviour should reflect the Respect principles of the FA and you as a manager. Warmley Rangers will not accept any abuse of Referee's, players or coaching staff and will report any incidents to the league and or FA.

Please remind parents that we do have neighbours and we would appreciate being respectful of them when using our facilities.

Clubhouse Bar & Food

We will have a fully licensed bar operating from the clubhouse with standard opening hours and we will also have a range of hot drinks, cold drinks, sweets, snacks and chocolate. We also have Sausage and Bacon baps available up until lunch time at very reasonable prices. Contactless payment is available in the clubhouse bar which also has 3 large TV screen showing football.

Note: The clubhouse is a member's bar, and all visitors must sign the visitors' book to use the facility.

Note: Our license means that No alcohol can be consumed by the pitches and cannot be taken beyond the clubhouse patio.

We have a "Keep Warmley Green" programme of work to ensure that the fields used for games are the best they can be for playing football. There are rubbish bins in the car park and around the fields, so please clear up after your team. If you are in doubt about what to do with your rubbish, please ask the Warmley manager for assistance.

Toilets

Temporary (portaloo) toilets are available in the car park for use by all visitors. Each toilet will have social distancing markers to prevent unsafe queuing and sanitising equipment within it. Please ensure your players and spectators sanitise the toilet before and after use. All toilets will be checked regularly by Warmley Rangers staff.

First Aid

No external first aider will be provided for games as all managers and many Warmley Rangers staff will be first aid trained through their FA level 1 qualification. It is expected that all teams bring their 1st aid kits with them as per FA regulations, however, should any equipment be needed, or an ambulance need to be called please contact the clubhouse.

Defib

We have a defib onsite which is located in the clubhouse behind the bar.

<u>Parking</u>

Parking is free at Redfield Edge. We have a car park with a capacity of 46 + 2 disabled spaces outside the clubhouse and if required an overflow car park on the grass at the top of the pitches will be made available, A member of Warmley Rangers FC will direct you as required.

Note: All Vehicles are parked at the owners' risk.
