Skills Challenge, April 23

Twenty-one Club members tested their shot-making abilities at five different skills. The following winners took home cash prizes.

- First Place, Alan Bensch
- Second Place, Richard Watson
- Third Place, Bob Knotz
- Fourth Place, Betty Anderson

Alan Bensch sincerely wants to thank everyone who participated in the challenge. Participation in this event was not the same as in other events we have organized. Virtually everyone was involved on the court in helping other players compete or recording player's results, as well as competing themselves. I hope that taking part in both sides of the experience was as satisfying for everyone as it was for me.

All the shot-making skills that made up the tests were fundamental to both Golf Croquet and American Rules 6-Wicket Croquet. They were:

- Set-up shots
- Stop Shots
- Clearing shots (or Roquet)
- Wicket shots
- Total number of shots to make a three-wicket sequence

Each player had two chances to try each test. All the tests were the same, but in the second pass through the course, most of the shooting distances were slightly longer. The average scores for the second pass were 10% lower reflecting the increased difficulty.

The course handicapper was pleased because no one came close to the target best score. The range of scores from the highest to the lowest was not large. We're concluding that all the players have some room for improvement, and the club as a whole is very competitive.
