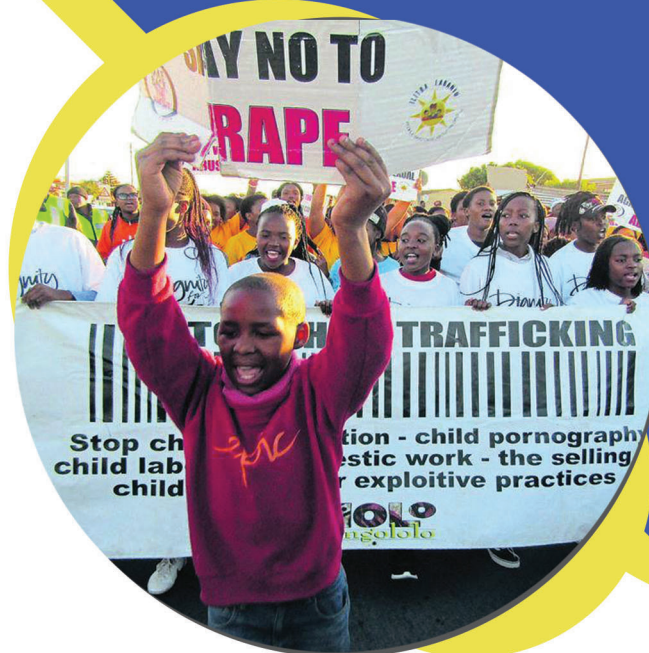

Targeting Atlantis, Beaufort West and Delft; and their surrounding areas. The programme;

- Provides direct assistance to child victims and those at risk and their family.
- Re-integrate child victims into family, school and community.
- Support and co-operate with DSD, SAPS and Prosecutors and support child and family during court cases.
- Create awareness and education about child trafficking and exploitation.
- Train & build capacity to improve services for victims.
- Advocate for increased government response and law reform to prevent and protect children.



## CHILD & YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

This programme target mainly school going learners in poor rural and urban communities to;

- Develop children's lifeskills, social competence and leadership skills
- Motivate children to make positive life choices and complete their schooling and open their world view to new possibilities.

- Counselling - working with the sexually traumatised child.
