- **Education & Enrichment:** Awarding **(6) \$1,000 Academic/Vocational Scholarships** and sponsoring local kids to attend **Kamp Kiwanis**, the premier accredited sleep-away camp.
- **Play & Learning:** Supplying and installing a **playground at the Newburgh Unity Center** and building a **Bike Garden at GAMS Elementary** to teach road safety.

- We support our veterans and keep our area beautiful through the **Adopt-A-Highway Program** cleanups (including the Purple Heart Museum frontage).
