## South Sound Chapter of Puget Sound Anglers


The Contest starts on March 31, 2018 and ends March 31, 2019. These dates coincide with WDF&W licensing renewal dates.

How to measure a fish for the Derby



Whenever possible submit a photo of the fish and the angler. Winning entries will be recognized at the 2018/19 South Sound Chapter of Puget Sound Chapter Anglers Annual Seafood Banquet. There will be some special mystery prizes awarded at the Banquet.

How to measure a fish for the Derby



*Note: Careful measurements may mean the difference between winning or losing. The winner may be won by a fraction of an inch. Lay the tape next to the fish and take a photo and include a photo of the fish & fisherperson.*

The following fish in each category will be winners in the Contest:

Largest - King Salmon, Coho, Chum, Pink and Sockeye

Largest Land Locked Salmon - Kokanee & Silvers

Largest - Steelhead and Rainbow (not steelhead) trout

Largest - Freshwater Bass and Yellow Perch

Largest pan fish - Crappie, Sunfish or Bluegill

Largest - Halibut, Lingcod, Rockfish and Surf Perch

Prizes yet to be determined. Contest entrants will be posted at the monthly meetings.
