
South Sound Chapter of Puget Sound Anglers

Entries must be measured and submitted via the attached form.




How to measure a fish for the Derby

How to measure a fish for the Derby



Note: Careful measurements may mean the difference between winning or losing. The winner may be won by a fraction of an inch. Lay the tape next to the fish and take a photo and include a photo of the fish & fisherperson.

The following fish in each category will be winners in the Contest:

Largest - King Salmon, Coho, Chum, Pink and Sockeye

Largest Land Locked Salmon - Kokanee & Silvers

Largest - Steelhead and Rainbow (not steelhead) trout

Largest - Freshwater Bass and Yellow Perch

Largest pan fish - Crappie, Sunfish or Bluegill

Largest - Halibut, Lingcod, Rockfish and Surf Perch
