CLUB MESSAGE Written by Vice President Allen Morrow

The South Sound Chapter's kid fishing activities are generating a lot of advertising for Puget Sound Anglers in general. There have been several recent instances of press coverage about our program through Cabela's and WDFW. This coverage has resulted Puget Sound Anglers being mentioned in a number of publications. The South Sound Chapter is mentioned in a few of them, but it is easier for the press to just say Puget Sound Anglers.

Our kid fishing activities have been coordinated with Go Play Outside Alliance of Washington (GoPAW) for many years. GoPAW has disbanded and South Sound Chapter is taking over its assets, which include the portable fish pond and the supporting equipment needed to allow kids to catch a fish. Inheriting the pond also means inheriting the Washington State Fair in Puyallup during the month of September. Last year, in conjunction with GoPAW, we reached 3,600 kids, between 4 and 15 years, old at the Fair and could have reached more if we would have had more volunteers. We are asking all PSA members to join us at the Fair. The Fair starts August 31st and runs through September 23. The fishing pond is open from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM Friday through Labor Day on the first weekend and Friday through Sunday for the rest of the Fair. Volunteers will receive two free entry tickets to the Fair and free parking. If you would like to join us please contact Mike Silvers at <u>setthehook55@gmail.com</u>. The Puget Sound Anglers banner will be prominently displayed on the pond. Remember these kids are the future of fishing in the state of Washington.

Our June speaker was Lee Warnaca of the Tacoma Maritime Institute. Lee gave a very educational and entertaining presentation on safety practices we all should follow while on the water. As a long time fisher and boater, I thought I was following proper practices, but learned that there are better ways. I strongly encourage those who haven't heard Lee speak to try to find an opportunity to hear him.

We have a couple of upcoming events on the calendar. The first is our annual garage sale on Saturday, July 21. This event is a major fund raiser for the club. Sale items need not be fishing related. We are looking for any item you might want to donate other than clothing. More information will be forthcoming.

The second event is a South Sound Chapter club member only fishing derby on Saturday, August 18. Current plans call for the derby to be based at Boston Harbor. The entry cost will be \$20.00 and prizes will be \$350.00 for 1st Place, \$150.00 for second, \$100.00 for 3rd and \$75.00 for the mystery fish. Again more information regarding this event will be forthcoming.
