CLUB MESSAGE Written by Vice President Allen Morrow

Recent reports from several members are that there are significant numbers of sublegal chinook in local water with a few keepers being caught. With this in mind, we had Steve Andrews, one of the premier South Sound fishers, as our July speaker. Steve gave a very educational and inspiring talk on when, where and how to fish for chinook in our area. He pointed out that last year over 29,000 chinook returned to the WDFW hatchery on the Deschutes River and that the prediction for this year is almost as large. He said that optimum timing of the run is between mid-July and the end of August. Steve has had success in years past using jigs and trolling a spoon. He prefers using artificial lures as there are a number of dog fish in the area and they can cause you to go through a package of herring quickly. His favorite spots are from Dana Passage to the south end of the Nisqually Reach.

Our August event will be the first South Sound Chapter salmon derby on August 18. This event is open only to members of our chapter, members of their household and their grandchildren under to age of 14. The derby will be based at the Boston Harbor Marina with the weigh station open from 8 AM to 3 PM. Fish will be weighed in the round. Participants must have a valid fishing license and everyone in the boat must have a derby ticket. The entry cost is \$20.00 (\$5.00 will be donated for Pancreatic Cancer Research). First place prize will be \$350.00, second place \$150.00, third place \$100.00 and the mystery fish winner will receive \$75.00. Tickets can be purchased at our August meeting.

Our August speaker will be Terry Rudnick, another stellar South Sound fisher, and a noted author of several how-to fish books. Terry will speak to us not only on fishing issues, but also on the critical need for more funding for Pancreatic Cancer Research. In addition to our derby on August 18, Terry will be sponsoring a "breakfast on the water" fund raiser at his home on Dana Passage. Those wanting to donate to the cause will be served breakfast on their boat. Additional information will be available at our August meeting and on our web site.

Looking ahead we will have our portable fish pond at the Washington State Fair every weekend during its entire run in September. The fish pond is open from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM Friday through Sunday and on Labor Day. To make this project a success we must depend on many volunteer hours.
