

SAULT STE. MARIE HOUSING COMMISSION GRILL POLICY

The Sault Ste. Marie Housing Commission recognizes the importance of providing a living environment of safety for its residents. To achieve this control the Commission has adopted a Grill Policy that will be implemented by the Housing Commission.

All grills must be used a minimum of 10 feet from all Housing Commission owned structures at grade level, overhanging branches and other combustible materials. When not in use, grills must be stored at a minimum of 3 feet from any Housing Commission owned structures. Grills cannot be stored inside dwelling units, on porches or decks.

Due to liability, portable charcoal grill usage is prohibited.

All grilling activities must comply with local fire codes and regulations. Do not leave a grill unattended while in use. Tenants are responsible for maintaining their grill and ensure it is safe to use. For safety purposes, it is recommended for tenants to keep a fire extinguisher nearby and ensure it is accessible. Tenants are liable for any damage caused by improper use of grills.

The Housing Commission reserves the right to restrict or revoke grilling privileges if safety rules are not followed.
