The SD serves students interested in a masters-equivalent educational program that more deeply explores various theological and ministerial areas of study.

\_\_\_ Sahafe Haymanot (SH) (SH – 79 credit hours): The SH (otherwise known as “Certificate in Exegetical and Practical Theology”) reflects the traditional Master of Divinity (M.Div.) degree as an advanced survey of biblical and theological courses including philological and exegetical education. The SH aids ministry leaders interested in gaining faculty in biblical exegesis as well as advanced leadership administration.
