**The Kinh 7 Charity Clinic Team and Project** 



ICI has supported collaborative efforts of the Kinh 7 Charity Clinic, located in Kien Giang, Vietnam, to renovate its dining hall and lodging area as well as to provide training for clinic staff and strengthen sustainable community health education programs for the 25-year old charity clinic in 2015.

The project's goal was to rebuild the heavily deteriorated and collapsing kitchen facility being used by interfaith volunteer groups to provide free meals for 250 to 350 patients and caregivers daily. In addition, this project added a lower level extended stay rooms for the clinic volunteers and upper level guest rooms to accommodate short-term stay volunteer healthcare professionals, students and others who support the clinic's community health initiatives to serve the increasing needs and number of poor patients and caregivers in the Kinh 7 local and surrounding areas.

# Inaugural Mission December 2017








# ledical Mission Trips to Vietnam

# October 2018





The ICI team surveyed and received a project completion report for a **Clean Water Project**. This 4,000 liter-per-day filtration system installation provides purified water for drinking and improves standards of living for up to 10,000 people who are mostly Ede, Muong, and Kinh ethnic minorities in a rural community in the Buon Trap region of Dak Lak Province, Vietnam.

The team also conducted a **Vietnam Humanitarian and Medical Mission** in collaboration with its partner **Second Chance Aid (Ngon Nen Tinh Yeu)** organization to provide primary care and medications for about 1,000 patients in two rural and underserved communities in Kontum and Nam Dinh, Vietnam.

The ICI team provided training on diabetes with a focus on insulin therapy and blood glucose monitoring for over 40 clinic staff at the Kinh 7 Charity Clinic in Kien Giang, Vietnam. Additionally, the team worked with Kinh 7 Charity Clinic leaders to complete a needs assessment and plan for the ICI 2019 Public Health and Medical Mission.

Our team visited with "Mai Am Tinh Me" – an orphanage with 25 children – to assess their needs to support their daily living and education. As a result of the ask for support and this needs assessment, ICI facilitates supporters for \$1 to \$2 per day (\$365 to \$730 a year) per child to provide basic needs and education for these children. #### WHAT WAS ACCOMPLISHED?

- ⇒ Provided primary care and medications for 986 patients and food for 800 people for the M'nông ethnic minority in a rural, underserved community in Bon Bulum, Dak Nong Province, Vietnam. - ⇒ Visited Mai Am Tinh Me orphanage in Kien Giang, Vietnam and provided food and education support for orphanage children.

# Clean Water Project







In many of the ethnic minority villages in Vietnam, villagers face extreme conditions all year round due to the lack of food and water. For generations, their only source of water has been from ravines and rock crevices, which are heavily polluted by deforestation, indiscriminate exploitation of land, and extremely toxic chemicals from fertilizers, drugs, insecticide, pesticides and herbicides. This water is a great harm to their health and is the culprit of the most prominent illnesses including gastrointestinal diseases, especially diarrhea. These diseases sometimes lead to lost lives. Disease is common, from birth to adult, due to polluted water. In fact, the high life-expectancy only reaches the age of 50.

As of December 2020, ICI has collaborated with our partners to provide 8 free purified water systems to over 41,000 villagers from many ethnic minorities at Dak Ha, Kontum (2020), Dak Neang, Kontum (2020), Dak Wet, Kontum (2020), Quang Truc, Dak Nong (2019), Dak N'drung (2019), Buon Trap (2018), Dak Ya (2016), and IA Tiem (2015) communities. Each water well and filtration system included: 5 years of maintenance and 4,000 liters of purified and safe drinking water daily, including humanitarian relief to the poorest village families. Since the beginning of the project, local vicars have enthusiastically stated that "The whole village no longer has a stomach ache!" In fact, the father rarely has to distribute gastrointestinal medicine anymore, as very few people need medications due to improved water conditions. Since the majority of people living in the villages have clean water for domestic use, diseases that people often contract from the use of polluted water have been reduced. Additionally, the majority of the villagers have changed their behaviors on health and personal hygiene as a result of the education provided.

The impact of this project is farreaching and indispensable. It is also
greatly rewarding, as the money
donated to this water project saves
the villagers at risk of disease. Not
only has health improved, but labor
and the economy has improved as
well. The future and destiny of the

### HANDICAPPED KIDS SUPPORT



The Khuyết Tật Tình Thương Mỹ Lâm School of Disabilities belongs to Caritas in Diocese of Long Xuyen, which was built in 1994. This is a charitable institution that teaches culture and careers to children with disabilities in Kien Giang Province and the surrounding region, creating favorable conditions that let them integrate with the social community. The school trains children to become cultural, ethical, and responsible people who are self-reliant.

# aiti Mission Work









May 29 - June 5, 2016: A team including ICI president who is also a pharmacy professor, and five pharmacy and physical therapy students at University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES), School of Pharmacy & Health Professions, and three non-healthcare volunteers joined a Haiti Medical Mission, organized by Dr. Frank Nice and Mrs. Pat Labuda who started Haiti missions over 20 years with Health and Education for Haiti (HEH) and St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church (SFA). During the mission, the team conducted health needs assessments at a clinic, set up a pharmacy, provided health care and medications for children at an orphanage and a clinic. Upon returning, ICI organized an inaugural Haiti Mission Charity Banquet on October 8, 2016 and a second Haiti Mission Charity Banquet on September 22, 2017 in collaboration with HEH, SFA and UMES and raised over \$13,000 for a future mission to Haiti.

**February 3-11, 2018:** ICI president and another pharmacy faculty, physicians, nurses, and three UMES pharmacy students joined another Haiti Medical Mission, also organized by Mrs. Pat Labuda with HEH and SFA. The team provided primary care for 1,010 patients who had 1,307 medical conditions and dispensed 1,877 medications over 5 clinic days. #### WHAT WAS ACCOMPLISHED?

June 2, 2018: ICI, in collaboration with the University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) School of Pharmacy and Health Professions, Maryland Pharmaceutical Society (MPhS), and Maryland Pharmacists Association (MPhA), organized a Puerto Rico Post-Hurricane Relief and Medical Mission Fundraising Banquet and raised about \$4,700 for a mission to Utuado, Puerto Rico.
