As we wrap up the year 2018, it is rewarding to reflect on our mission and programs, yet more importantly on your generosity and kind support through sharing your time, expertise, and financial contributions to make our service and progress possible. We may speak different languages and have different talents, yet we share a common bond – the language of humanity, with our family and friends, as well as those who are less fortunate. It has been an honor and privilege to work with you throughout the year. We would like to share our collective efforts as a summary of "ICI Annual Report 2018" to reflect the achievements of our ICI mission and team.

## ICI Activities & Achievements in 2018

- ✓ February 3-11: ICI team participated in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Haiti Medical Mission, in which ICI collaborated with St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church, Health and Education for Haiti, and University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) School of Pharmacy and Health Professions, and raised about \$4850 at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Haiti Medical Mission Charity Banquet on September 22, 2017.
- ✓ May 20: Organized the 3<sup>rd</sup> Vietnam Humanitarian Mission & Internships Fundraising Banquet in the Washington DC Metropolitan and raised about \$8,700 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Public Health & Medical Mission to the Kinh 7 Charity Clinic in Kien Giang, Vietnam from April 20 to 29, 2019 in collaboration with the UMES School of Pharmacy and Health Professions.
- ✓ May 27: Organized the 1<sup>st</sup> Vietnam Humanitarian Mission & Internships Fundraising Banquet in Anaheim, CA, with special thanks to Vietnamese Professional Singer Ms. Thien-Kim Tran, and raised about \$20,000 for Vietnam Humanitarian Mission & Internships in collaboration with the UMES School of Pharmacy and Health Professions.
- ✓ June 2: Organized a Puerto Rico Post-Hurricane Relief & Medical Mission Fundraising Banquet in Gaithersburg, MD and raised about \$4,700 for a mission to Utuado, Puerto Rico in Spring 2019 in collaboration with the Maryland Pharmaceutical Society (MPhS), Maryland Pharmacists Association (MPhA), and UMES School of Pharmacy and Health Professions.
- ✓ October 25: ICI team surveyed and received project completion report from a partnership with the Environment Communication Community Development Association (ECCDA) on a Clean Water Project in which 4,000 liter-per-day filtration system installation provides purified water for drinking and improving standards of living for up to 10,000 people who mostly are Ede, Muong, and Kinh ethnic minority among others in a rural community in the Buon Trap region of Dak Lak Province, Vietnam.
- ✓ October 26-29: ICI team participated in a Vietnam Humanitarian & Medical Mission in collaboration with Second Chance Aid (Ngon Nen Tinh Yeu) organization to provide primary care and medications for about 1000 patients in two rural and underserved communities in Kontum and Nam Dinh, Vietnam.

- ✓ October 30: ICI team provided training on diabetes with a focus on insulin therapy and blood glucose monitoring for over 40 clinic staff at the Kinh 7 Charity Clinic in Kien Giang, Vietnam. In addition, ICI team worked with Kinh 7 Charity Clinic leaders to complete a needs assessment and plan for the ICI 2019 Public Health & Medical Mission in collaboration with UMES School of Pharmacy & Health Professions.
- ✓ October 31: ICI team visited and discussed with "Mai Am Tinh Me" an orphanage with 25 children to assess their needs and support with daily living and education. As a result of a previous request for support and this needs assessment, ICI will ask supporters for \$1 to \$2 per day which is \$365 to \$730 per year per child going forward in 2019 and beyond. Please contact us if you have questions and would like to help.

In 2018, ICI's main priorities have been on fundraising, planning and preparing for Vietnam Humanitarian Mission & Internships and Puerto Rico Post-Hurricane Relief & Medical Mission in 2019, as well as participation in Haiti and Vietnam Medical Missions, completed the Clean Water Project in Buon Trap, Vietnam as described above.
