## ICI Activities & Achievements in 2019

- ✓ April 3, 2019: Organized the first Cancer Awareness and Education Event in collaboration with University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) and Montgomery County Health Department (MCHD).
- ✓ April 22–27, 2019: Conducted the 2<sup>nd</sup> Vietnam Public Health & Medical Mission to Kinh 7 Charity Clinic in Kien Giang (southern region) for 1024 patients and to Dak Nong (central highland region) for 986 patients. - ✓ May 24, 2019: Organized the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual ICI Vietnam Humanitarian Mission & Internships Fundraising Banquet in Anaheim, CA, with special thanks to Vietnamese Professional Singer Ms. Thien-Kim Tran and raised over \$18,000.
- ✓ June 2, 2019: Organized the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual ICI Vietnam Humanitarian Mission & Internships Fundraising Banquet in Falls Church, VA and raised over \$9,000.
- ✓ June 12–15, 2019: Organized the first Puerto Rico Post Hurricane Relief & Medical Mission Utuado, Puerto Rico, a rural mountain region that is still recovering from Hurricane Maria in 2017, in collaboration with the Maryland Pharmacists Association, Maryland Pharmaceutical Society and UMES.
- ✓ August 18, 2019: Completed a Clean Water Project in which 4,000 liter-per-day filtration system installation provides purified water for drinking and improving standards of living for up to 10,000 people who mostly are ethnic minority in a rural community in Bon Bu Lum, Quang Truc, Dak Nong, Vietnam in collaboration with the Environment Communication Community Development Association (ECCDA).
- ✓ October 12, 2019: Organized the first Community Health Event in collaboration with University of Maryland Eastern Shore (UMES) and Montgomery County Health Department (MCHD).
- ✓ October 25–31, 2019: Participated in a Vietnam Humanitarian Mission to central highland region in Vietnam with Second Chance Aid (Ngon Nen Tinh Yeu), a partner non-profit organization in Atlanta, GA.
- ✓ December 1: ICI sent donation to "Mai Am Tinh Me" an orphanage with 27 children to support their daily living and education. As a result of a previous request for support and needs assessment in 2018, ICI

asked supporters for \$1 to \$2 per day which is \$365 to \$730 per year per child starting in 2019 and beyond. Please contact us if you would like to help or sponsor a child.

✓ December 31, 2019: Completed a Clean Water Project in which 4,000 liter-per-day filtration system installation provides purified water for drinking and improving standards of living for up to 10,000 people who mostly are ethnic minority in a rural community in Bon Bu-Dop / Bu-Xoay / Kinh, Dak N'drung, Dak Nong, Vietnam in collaboration with the (ECCDA).

In 2019, ICI's main priorities have been on organizing and conducting Vietnam Humanitarian Missions & Internships in April and Puerto Rico Post-Hurricane Relief & Medical Mission in June with many collaborative partners, as well as planning and participating in a variety of local community health events.
