The Landlord: "Baron Von Heron" (The Great Blue Heron)

- **Vibe:** The Enforcer / Undisputed Heavyweight Champ.
- **The "Fly-By":** Baron Von Heron doesn't do "subtle". When he decides it's time for Edgar to leave, he flies directly at him to force a move.
- **The Victory Pose:** After he successfully runs Edgar off, Baron Von Heron will often stand tall and spread his massive 6-foot wingspan. It's his way of "planting the flag" and reminding the entire waterfront who owns the deed to these docks.

The Specialist: "Edgar" (The Great Egret)

- **Vibe:** Elegant Professional / Patient Panhandler.

- **The Strategy:** Unlike the seagulls, you won't find Edgar scavenging at the fish cleaning table. He prefers to stand off at a polite distance, "panhandling" for a fresh catch.
- **The Routine:** Edgar is a persistent tenant. Baron Von Heron will evict him from one end of the dock, and Edgar will simply fly to the other end to start his stealthy fishing all over again.

- **Want to help Edgar out?** We have fishing poles ready to go for our guests!
- If you catch a small Perch while fishing off the docks, feel free to toss it over to Edgar if he's nearby.
