New Testament Reading: Romans 10:1-13

My heart's desire and prayer to God for them is that they may be saved.
I can testify that they have a zeal for God, but it is not enlightened.
For, being ignorant of the righteousness that comes from God,
and seeking to establish their own, they have not submitted to God's righteousness.
For Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes.
Moses writes concerning the righteousness that comes from the law,
that "the person who does these things will live by them."
But the righteousness that comes from faith says,
"Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down)
"or 'Who will descend into the abyss?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).
But what does it say?
"The word is near you, on your lips and in your heart"
(that is, the word of faith that we proclaim);
because if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised
him from the dead, you will be saved.
For one believes with the heart and so is justified,
and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved.
The scripture says, "No one who believes in him will be put to shame."
For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek;
the same Lord is Lord of all and is generous to all who call on him.
For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

The Gospel: Luke 24:36-48

While they were talking about this,
Jesus himself stood among them and said to them,
"Peace be with you."
They were startled and terrified, and thought that they were seeing a ghost.
He said to them, "Why are you frightened, and why do doubts arise in your hearts?
Look at my hands and my feet; see that it is I myself.
Touch me and see; for a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you see that I have."
And when he had said this, he showed them his hands and his feet.
While in their joy they were disbelieving and still wondering, he said to them,
"Have you anything here to eat?"
They gave him a piece of broiled fish, and he took it and ate in their presence.
Then he said to them,
"These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you —
that everything written about me in the law of Moses, the prophets, and the psalms must be fulfilled."
Then he opened their minds to understand the scriptures, and he said to them,
"Thus it is written, that the Messiah is to suffer and to rise from the dead on the third day,
and that repentance and forgiveness of sins is to be proclaimed in his name to all nations,
beginning from Jerusalem.
You are witnesses of these things.

Saint Zélie Martin: A Model of Motherhood and Holiness in Daily Life

On Mother's Day, the Church gives thanks for all mothers—those who nurture life, form hearts in faith, and quietly reflect the love of God in their families. Among the many witnesses to Christian motherhood, Saint Zélie Martin offers a profound example of holiness lived not in extraordinary circumstances, but in the ordinary and sometimes difficult realities of family life.



Saint Zélie Martin was born in 1831 in Alençon, France. From a young age, she felt drawn to religious life, but after discernment, she came to believe that God was calling her instead to marriage and motherhood. She would later write that although she once desired to become a religious sister, she found her true vocation in raising a family for God.

She married Louis Martin, and together they built a deeply Christian household marked by prayer, discipline, and love. Their marriage is one of the most beautiful examples of Catholic family life in modern Church history. In 2015, Pope Francis canonized them together, recognizing not only their individual holiness but also the sanctity of their marriage and family life.

The Martins experienced both joy and suffering. They were blessed with nine children, but also endured the sorrow of losing several in infancy. Zélie herself suffered from breast cancer, which eventually led to her early death at the age of 45. Yet throughout her life, she remained a woman of deep faith, trusting in God even amid grief and hardship.

Zélie is remembered especially for her devotion as a mother. She supported her family through her lace-making business, working diligently while also caring for the spiritual formation of her children. She saw motherhood not as a burden, but as a sacred responsibility entrusted to her by God. In her letters, she often expressed concern for her children's souls, praying that each would grow in holiness and discover God's will for their lives.

Her youngest daughter, Saint Thérèse of Lisieux, would later become one of the most beloved saints in the Church. Thérèse herself testified that the love, faith, and example of her parents were essential in shaping her vocation and spiritual life.

Together with her husband Louis, Zélie is now honored not only as a saint, but also as a patron of married couples, parents, and family life. Their canonization as a couple emphasizes the Church's teaching that marriage is a path to holiness and that the family is a true domestic church, where faith is lived and passed on.

Zélie's feast day is celebrated on **July 12**, shared with her husband Louis. On this day, the Church remembers their witness as a couple who lived ordinary life with extraordinary faith. They remind us that sanctity is not reserved for the cloister or the extraordinary, but is possible in the home, in daily work, and in the faithful endurance of life's joys and sorrows.

On Mother's Day, Saint Zélie Martin speaks with special relevance. She understands the joys and struggles of motherhood—the sleepless nights, the worries for children, the sacrifices made quietly and without recognition. Yet she also shows that these very moments can become paths to holiness when united with love and trust in God.

Her life encourages mothers today to see their vocation not only as a duty, but as a sacred calling. Every act of patience, every prayer for a child, every sacrifice made in love participates in God's own creative and sustaining love for the world.

As we honor mothers today, we give thanks for their daily witness of faith and love. We ask Saint Zélie Martin to intercede for all families, that homes may be filled with peace, patience, and trust in God. May all mothers be strengthened in their vocation, and may all families grow in holiness through the grace of Christ.


