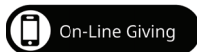

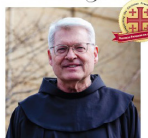

First Holy Communion Program – It is **required** that your child attend 1st Grade to make their First Communion in 2nd Grade. **If your child did not attend 1st Grade, please contact Krista Joseph ASAP to arrange for your child to get caught up to receive First Holy Communion on time.**

Confirmation – We will be Confirming 4th, 5th, and 8th Grade students this 2026-2027 School Year. The Diocese of Columbus has NEW directives to move Confirmation to 4th Grade. See the video from Bishop Fernandes on our website with more information about this. Over the next two years, we will be confirming Grades 4 through 8 to get everyone caught up. In 2027-2028, we will confirm 4th, 7th, and 8th Grade.

New Testament Reading: 2Corinthians 5:20-6:10

Concerning spiritual gifts, I do not want you to be uninformed.
You know that when you were pagans,
you were enticed and led astray to idols that could not speak.
Therefore I want you to understand Let Jesus be cursed!"
and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except by the Holy Spirit.
Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit;
and there are varieties of services, but the same Lord;
and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who activates all of them in everyone.
To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.
To one is given through the Spirit the utterance of wisdom,
and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same Spirit,
to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit,
to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the discernment of spirits,
to another various kinds of tongues,
to another the interpretation of tongues.
All these are activated by one and the same Spirit,
who allots to each one individually just as the Spirit chooses.

The Gospel: Matthew 12:22-32

They brought to Jesus a demoniac who was blind and mute; and he cured him,
so that the one who had been mute could speak and see.
All the crowds were amazed and said, "Can this be the Son of David?"
But when the Pharisees heard it, they said, "It is only by Beelzebul, the ruler of the demons,
that this fellow casts out the demons."
He knew what they were thinking and said to them, "Every kingdom divided against itself is
laid waste, and no city or house divided against itself will stand.
If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself; how then will his kingdom stand?
If I cast out demons by Beelzebul, by whom do your own exorcists cast them out?
Therefore they will be your judges.
But if it is by the Spirit of God that I cast out demons, then the kingdom of God has come to you.
Or how can one enter a strong man's house and plunder his property, without first tying up
the strong man?
Then indeed the house can be plundered.
Whoever is not with me is against me, and whoever does not gather with me scatters.
Therefore I tell you, people will be forgiven for every sin and blasphemy, but blasphemy
against the Spirit will not be forgiven.
Whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man
will be forgiven,
but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit
will not be forgiven,
either in this age or in the age to come.

St. Macrina the Younger- Feast Day: July 19



On July 19, the Church honors St. Macrina the Younger, a woman whose quiet holiness helped shape some of the greatest saints in Christian history. Though she never held public office or sought recognition, her unwavering faith, profound wisdom, and life of prayer left a lasting mark on the Church that continues to inspire us today.

Born around A.D. 327 in Cappadocia (present-day Turkey), Macrina was the eldest of ten children in a deeply Christian family. Her parents, St. Basil the Elder and St. Emmelia, nurtured their children in the faith, teaching them to love God above all else. Among her siblings were St. Basil the Great, St. Gregory of Nyssa, and St. Peter of Sebaste, all of whom became bishops and saints. Yet these remarkable men often acknowledged that it was Macrina who first taught them how to live a life fully devoted to Christ.

As a young woman, Macrina was engaged to be married. When her fiancé died before their wedding, she chose to remain unmarried, consecrating her life entirely to the Lord. Rather than pursuing wealth or status, she transformed her family's estate into a Christian community where prayer, manual labor, and care for the poor were central to daily life. Those who lived with her shared their possessions, prayed together, and sought to imitate the simplicity of the early Christian community described in the Acts of the Apostles.

Macrina possessed a remarkable gift of spiritual wisdom. Her brother, St. Gregory of Nyssa, recorded many conversations with her and referred to her as his teacher. As she approached death, she spoke not with fear but with joyful confidence in Christ's promise of eternal life. Her final prayer expressed complete trust in God's mercy and the hope of the Resurrection—a beautiful witness to the faith that sustained her throughout her life.

The life of St. Macrina reminds us that holiness is often found in ordinary acts of love, sacrifice, and fidelity. She never preached to large crowds or traveled the world, yet through her example she formed saints, strengthened her family, cared for the needy, and helped shape Christian theology through those she inspired. Her influence demonstrates that every vocation, lived faithfully, can become a path to sanctity.

In today's busy world, St. Macrina invites us to rediscover the importance of prayer, silence, humility, and trust in God. She reminds us that our greatest accomplishments are not measured by worldly success but by our faithfulness to Christ. Whether we serve within our families, our parish, our workplace, or our community, our quiet witness may touch lives in ways we will never fully know.

As we celebrate the feast of St. Macrina the Younger, may we ask for her intercession, that we may grow in wisdom, persevere in prayer, and live each day with confidence in God's loving providence. May her example inspire us to seek holiness in the ordinary moments of life and to place Christ at the center of all we do.
