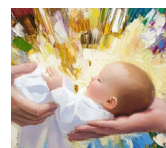


The parish office will be closed on Friday, July 3 in observance of Independence Day. We wish you all a safe, happy 4th of July!!

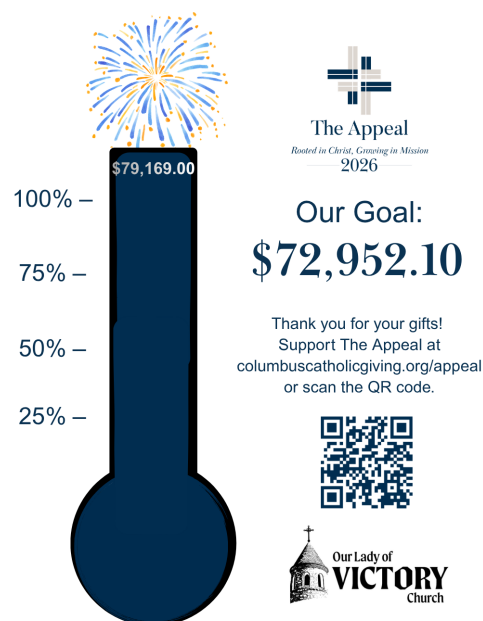

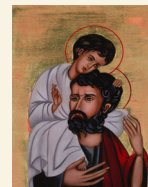
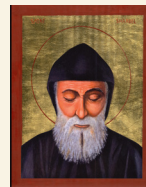

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New Testament Reading: 1Corinthians 12:12-13,27-30

Just as the body is one and has many members,
and all the members of the body,
though many, are one body, so it is with Christ.
For in the one Spirit we were all baptized into one body
— Jews or Greeks, slaves or free —
and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.
Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.
And God has appointed in the church first apostles,
second prophets, third teachers;

The Gospel: Matthew 10:16-25

“See, I am sending you out like sheep into the midst of wolves;
so be wise as serpents and innocent as doves.
Beware of them, for they will hand you over to councils and flog you in their synagogues;
and you will be dragged before governors and kings because of me,

Saint Irenaeus of Lyons - Feast Day: July 28

Each year on June 28, the Church honors St. Irenaeus of Lyons, one of the most important theologians and defenders of the Christian faith in the early centuries of the Church. In 2022, Pope Francis officially proclaimed St. Irenaeus a Doctor of the Church, giving him the title Doctor Unitatis (“Doctor of Unity”) because of his efforts to preserve and strengthen the unity of Christians through sound teaching and faithful witness.

St. Irenaeus was born around A.D. 130 in Smyrna, a city in Asia Minor (modern-day Turkey). As a young man, he had the privilege of learning from St. Polycarp, who had been a disciple of St. John the Apostle.

Through this connection, Irenaeus received teachings that were passed down directly from those who had known Jesus Christ. This apostolic foundation would later shape his life's work.



As a missionary priest, Irenaeus traveled to Gaul, present-day France, where he served the Christian community in the city of Lyon. During a time of persecution, many Christians suffered for their faith, including the bishop of Lyon, St. Pothinus, who died as a martyr. Following his death, Irenaeus was chosen to become bishop around A.D. 178.

One of the greatest challenges facing the Church during Irenaeus's lifetime was the spread of Gnosticism. The Gnostics taught that salvation came through secret knowledge rather than through faith in Jesus Christ. They often rejected the goodness of God's creation and distorted the teachings handed down by the apostles. Irenaeus recognized the danger these ideas posed to Christian belief and worked tirelessly to defend the truth.

His most famous work, *Against Heresies*, carefully refuted Gnostic teachings and explained the authentic faith of the Church. In this work, he emphasized that the Church's teachings were not hidden or secret but openly proclaimed through Scripture, apostolic tradition, and the authority of the bishops who succeeded the apostles. His writings helped preserve Christian doctrine and continue to influence theology today.

One of Irenaeus's most beautiful teachings is his understanding of God's plan for humanity. He described salvation as a process by which Christ restores and renews all things. Through His Incarnation, Jesus entered human history to redeem what had been lost through sin. Irenaeus famously wrote, “The glory of God is man fully alive; and the life of man is the vision of God.” This profound statement reminds us that God desires not our diminishment but our flourishing in communion with Him.

St. Irenaeus also promoted peace and unity within the Church. During disagreements among Christians about the date of Easter, he encouraged patience and charity rather than division. His commitment to maintaining unity while remaining faithful to the truth earned him the title “Doctor of Unity.”

Although the details of his death are uncertain, tradition holds that he died around A.D. 202. For centuries, Christians have honored him as a saint, recognizing his courage, wisdom, and devotion to Christ.

The life of St. Irenaeus reminds us of the importance of knowing our faith and remaining rooted in the teachings handed down through the Church. In a world filled with competing voices and conflicting ideas, his example encourages us to seek truth, cherish unity, and place our trust in Jesus Christ.

May St. Irenaeus of Lyons intercede for us, helping us to grow in faith, wisdom, and love for the Church, so that we too may become witnesses to the truth of the Gospel.

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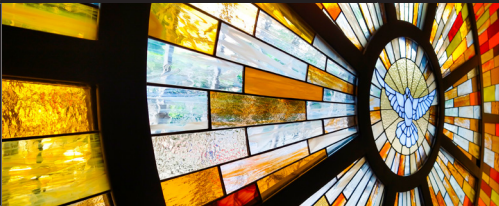
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
