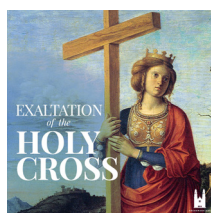

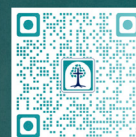

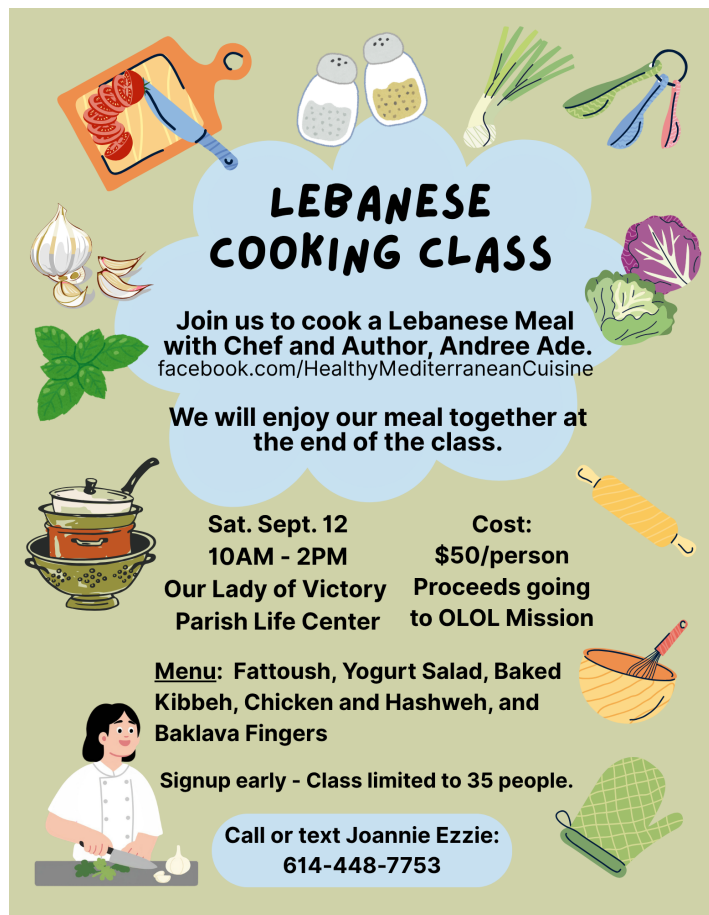

The Sacrament of Confirmation is not only meant for young teens. Adults of any age are welcome to prepare to receive this sacrament and deepen their relationship with Christ, strengthen their understanding of the Catholic faith, and receive the Gifts of the Holy Spirit in a special way.

RELIGIOUS ED REGISTRATION – ***Registration began online on August 1.*** The Registration Link and information will be emailed to you as well as posted on the OLV Website. **PLEASE** register ASAP, so you can reserve your child's spot in their class.

If you are already a registered member of our parish and it is your child's first year in our program, please email us with all your information to be on our mailing list.

If you are new to our parish, you need to be a REGISTERED member of OLV for your child to attend Religious Education. Parish Registration is available online on the OLV website. Contact Krista Joseph to begin the Religious Ed Registration process if you are new to our parish and program.

First Holy Communion Program – It is ***required*** that your child attend 1st Grade to make their First Communion in 2nd Grade. **If your child did not attend 1st Grade, please contact Krista Joseph ASAP to arrange for your child to get caught up to receive First Holy Communion on time.**

Confirmation – We will be Confirming 4th, 5th, and 8th Grade students this 2026-2027 School Year. The Diocese of Columbus has NEW directives to move Confirmation to 4th Grade. See the video from Bishop Fernandes on our website with more information about this. Over the next two years, we will be confirming Grades 4 through 8 to get everyone caught up. In 2027-2028, we will confirm 4th, 7th, and 8th Grade.

If your child has missed First Holy Communion or Confirmation and would like to receive these sacraments, please contact **Krista Joseph, Director of Religious Education – religioused@ourladyofvictory.cc**.

New Testament Reading: 1Thessalonians 1: 1-10

Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace.

We always give thanks to God for all of you and mention you in our prayers, constantly remembering before our God and Father your work of faith and labour of love and steadfastness of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.

For we know, brothers and sisters beloved by God, that he has chosen you, because our message of the gospel came to you not in word only,

but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction;

just as you know what kind of persons we proved to be among you for your sake.

And you became imitators of us and of the Lord,

for in spite of persecution you received the word with joy inspired by the Holy Spirit,

so that you became an example to all the believers in Macedonia and in Achaia.

And Jesus said to him, "You have judged rightly."

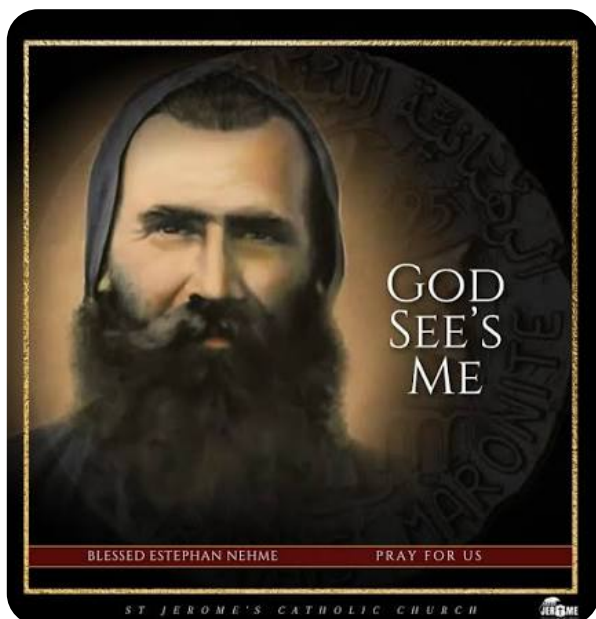
Then turning toward the woman, he said to Simon, "Do you see this woman?"

Blessed Estephan Nehme - Feast day: August 30



On the holy ground of Lebanon, Brother Estephan Nehme saw the light, under the wings of the Maronite Church he grew up and in the care of the Lebanese Maronite Order he flourished. He was inspired by the spirit of worship and the motivation to become holy, transferring them in his turn to upcoming generations.

Born in Lehfed, on March 8th, 1889, his parents named him Youssef. Growing up, he preferred to not to be very sociable, even among family. On the contrary, he preferred to stay at home and pray late at night. Afterwards, he went to bed and repeated: “God sees me, God sees me. Jesus, Mary and Saint Joseph, help me at the moment of death.”

In 1905, when he was 16 years old, Youssef left his parental house heading to the Monastery of Saints Cyprian and Justine in Kfifane in order to become a monk. Eight days later, he wore the novices' cassock and took the name of “Estephanos.”

On August 23rd, 1907, the Superior of the Convent, Father Youssef Saker, received the first monastic vows of Brother Estephan. Blessed Estephan spent 31 years in monastic life.

Brother Estephan was a “working monk.” He worked in the fields and gardens of the monastery, carrying his childhood motto of “God sees me” in everything he did. Brother Estephan had a pious life that ended virtuously at the Monastery of Saints Cyprian and Justine, on August 30th, 1938.

This humble monk passed away at the age of 49. His work in the fields as well as his presence in the different convents were characterized by his humanitarian, Christian and monastic spirit. His legacy is still alive and shining to this very day. Brother Estephan was buried in the monastery of Kfifane. Later, on March 10th, 1951, as the monks were burying the late Father Youssef Souraty, they found the body of Brother Estephan intact. It was a sign that confirmed what they already knew about him, that he lived and died in the grace of God.

Then, he was moved to a new tomb where he lays today and where visitors seek his intercession or ask the grace of healing. Brother Estephan was Beatified on June 27th, 2010.

The Church now awaits another miracle through his intercession to declare him as saint upon her altars.
