New Testament Reading: Philippians 3:17-4:1

The Gospel: Matthew 24:23-31

and the powers of heaven will be shaken.
Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven,

and they will see ‘the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven’
with power and great glory.
And he will send out his angels with a loud trumpet call,
and they will gather his elect from the four winds,
from one end of heaven to the other.”

St. John Henry Newman (1801–1890) – Feast Day: Oct. 9

St. John Henry Newman (1801–1890) is one of the most influential Christian thinkers of the modern age, remembered both for his deep faith and for his ability to bridge the worlds of faith and reason. Born in London, Newman was raised in the Anglican tradition. As a brilliant young man, he studied at Oxford, where he excelled in theology, philosophy, and classical literature. In time, he became a priest of the Church of England and a leader in the “Oxford Movement,” a 19th-century renewal effort that sought to recover the Catholic roots and traditions of Anglicanism. Newman’s writings during this time emphasized the importance of apostolic succession, the sacraments, and the continuity of the Church throughout history.



As he studied and prayed, Newman’s heart gradually turned toward the Catholic Church. In 1845, after years of struggle, he made his public conversion to Catholicism. For Newman, this was not a rejection of his past but a courageous step into the fullness of truth. His conversion shocked many in England, where Catholics were still often distrusted, but it also inspired countless others who admired his courage and sincerity. He was ordained a Catholic priest in 1847 and later created a cardinal in 1879 by Pope Leo XIII.

Newman’s accomplishments are vast, but his greatest legacy lies in his writings, which continue to speak to believers today. Among his most famous works are *An Essay on the Development of Christian Doctrine*, which explained how Catholic teachings grow organically from the truths handed down by the apostles, and *The Idea of a University*, a defense of liberal education that remains influential in Catholic and secular academic circles alike. He also wrote beautiful sermons, meditations, and prayers that reveal his deep love for Christ and His Church. Newman’s personal motto, taken when he became a cardinal, was “*Cor ad cor loquitur*” (“Heart speaks to heart”), a phrase that sums up his belief that faith is not just about arguments but about a personal encounter with the living God.

St. John Henry Newman is remembered as a patron of students, teachers, and converts to the Catholic faith. His lifelong devotion to the search for truth and his emphasis on conscience as “the aboriginal Vicar of Christ” in every human soul make him especially beloved by those navigating the challenges of modern life. He showed that faith and reason are not enemies but companions on the journey to God.

In 2010, Pope Benedict XVI beatified Newman during his visit to England, calling him “a great Englishman” and “a great Christian.” On October 13, 2019, Pope Francis canonized him as a saint of the universal Church. Today, his feast day is celebrated on October 9, honoring not only his entry into the Catholic Church but also his witness of courage, scholarship, and holiness.

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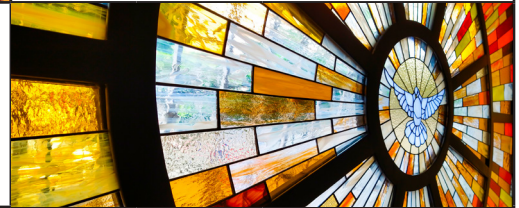
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
