New Testament Reading: Ephesians 2:1-10

You were dead through the trespasses and sin in which you once lived, following the course of this world, following the ruler of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work among those who are disobedient.

All of us once lived among them in the passions of our flesh, following the desires of flesh and senses, and we were by nature children of wrath, like everyone else.

But God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ – by grace you have been saved – and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God – not the result of works, so that no one may boast.

For we are what he has made us, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand to be our way of life.

The Gospel: John 21:15-19

When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, “Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?”

He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.”

Jesus said to him, “Feed my lambs.”

A second time he said to him, “Simon son of John, do you love me?”

He said to him, “Yes, Lord; you know that I love you.”

Jesus said to him, “Tend my sheep.”

He said to him the third time, “Simon son of John, do you love me?”

Peter felt hurt because he said to him the third time, “Do you love me?”

And he said to him, “Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you.”

Jesus said to him, “Feed my sheep.

Very truly, I tell you, when you were younger, you used to fasten your own belt and to go wherever you wished.

But when you grow old, you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will fasten a belt around you and take you where you do not wish to go.”

(He said this to indicate the kind of death by which he would glorify God.)

After this he said to him, “Follow me.”

Saint Juvenal of Narni – Feast Day: May 3

Saint Juvenal of Narni is one of the early bishops of the Church in Italy, remembered for his dedication to spreading the Gospel and strengthening Christian communities during a time when the faith was still taking root. Though less widely known than many saints, his life offers a compelling example of missionary zeal, pastoral care, and quiet perseverance.

Juvenal is believed to have lived during the 4th century, a pivotal period in Christian history. Following the legalization of Christianity under Emperor Constantine, the Church began to grow more openly, yet challenges remained. Pagan practices were still widespread, and many regions had only small or newly established Christian communities. It was in this environment that Juvenal served as bishop of Narni, a town in central Italy.

As bishop, Juvenal's primary mission was to guide and nurture the faithful. He worked to strengthen the local Church by preaching the Gospel, celebrating the sacraments, and fostering unity among believers. His role would have required both courage and patience, as he ministered in a society still adjusting to the presence and influence of Christianity.



Tradition holds that Juvenal was also a missionary, reaching out beyond the immediate Christian community to share the message of Christ with those who had not yet heard or accepted it. This outward focus reflects the essential mission of the Church: to bring the Good News to all people. Juvenal's efforts contributed to the gradual transformation of the region, helping to establish a lasting Christian presence.

In addition to his missionary work, Juvenal is remembered for his holiness of life. Like many early bishops, he would have been deeply committed to prayer, serving as both a spiritual leader and an example to his flock. His life likely embodied the virtues of humility, charity, and steadfast faith—qualities that inspired those around him and strengthened the Church from within.

Over time, devotion to Saint Juvenal grew, particularly in the region of Narni, where he is honored as a patron. His legacy is preserved not only in local tradition but also in the continued witness of the Church he helped to build. He stands as a reminder that the growth of Christianity was not the work of a few prominent figures alone, but also of many faithful shepherds who served quietly and faithfully in their communities.

Saint Juvenal's story speaks especially to those called to serve in ordinary but important ways. Not every saint is widely known, yet each plays a vital role in the life of the Church. His example encourages us to remain faithful in our own responsibilities, trusting that even small acts of service can contribute to God's greater work.

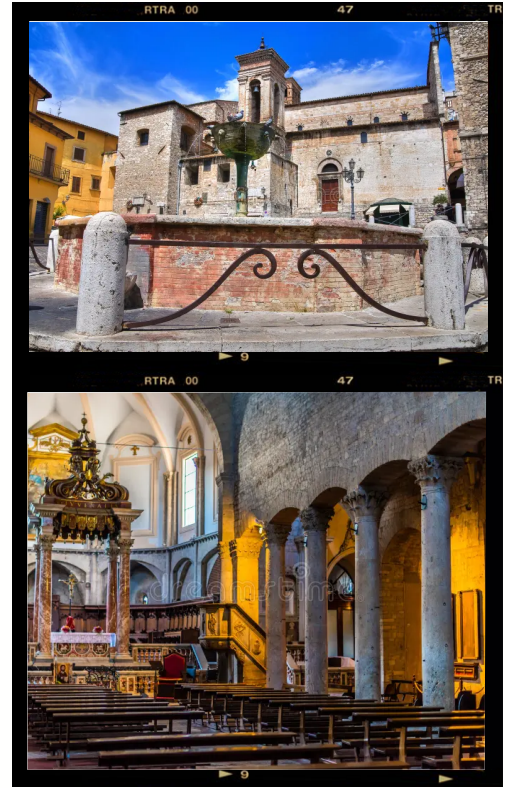

Like Juvenal, we are called to build up the Church where we are, with dedication and love.

In honoring Saint Juvenal of Narni, we remember the importance of perseverance, humility, and mission. His life invites us to deepen our commitment to Christ and to serve others faithfully, trusting that God works through every willing heart.

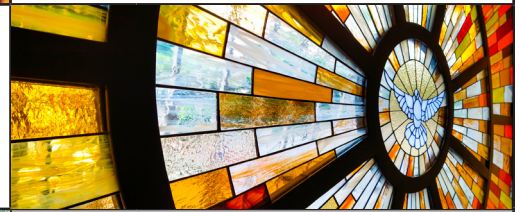
