

### MISSION APPEAL JUNE 28/29 AT OUR LADY OF VICTORY PARISH

This weekend, at the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, and the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Masses on Sunday, we will have Fr. Sunder Ery from the Diocese Missionary office here at OLV to speak about the Diocese of Cuddapah, located in India. It is made up of 66 parishes catering to over 80,000 Catholics.

The Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Cuddapah serves a critical and urgent need, reflecting the essence of compassion, faith, and community support. Its purpose is multifaceted, addressing the unique challenges faced by the local Dalith community, predominantly comprising the Catholic population.

**Addressing Poverty and Daily Struggles:** The Diocese of Cuddapah is home to a significant Dalith population, who are mired in poverty. Around 90% of these Catholics struggle to make ends meet as unskilled daily laborers in the agricultural sector. Their hand-to-mouth existence is characterized by the inability to provide regular meals for themselves and their children. The Mission Appeal acknowledges their dire circumstances and seeks to alleviate their immediate suffering.

**Fostering Faith Formation and Empowering Through Education:** The Mission Appeal goes beyond immediate relief by offering free education to the first generation of children in these villages who are attending school. Education is a powerful tool for breaking the cycle of poverty.

**Building Community Spaces:** In addition to education and faith formation, the Mission Appeal recognizes the need for village chapels in certain mission stations. These chapels not only provide a sacred space for worship but also serve as a gathering place for various community activities and support networks. They strengthen the sense of unity and belonging among the local population, fostering a stronger community spirit.

In summary, the Mission Appeal for the Diocese of Cuddapah is driven by a deep sense of empathy and responsibility toward a marginalized and impoverished community. Its purpose is to provide essential support, education, and spiritual guidance to those who are struggling to make ends meet.



### **New Testament Reading: 1Corinthians 2:11-16**

For what human being knows what is truly human except the human spirit that is within? So also no one comprehends what is truly God's except the Spirit of God. Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit that is from God, so that we may understand the gifts bestowed on us by God. And we speak of these things in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the Spirit, interpreting spiritual things to those who are spiritual. Those who are unspiritual do not receive the gifts of God's Spirit, for they are foolishness to them, and they are unable to understand them because they are spiritually discerned. Those who are spiritual discern all things, and they are themselves subject to no one else's scrutiny. "For who has known the mind of the Lord so as to instruct him?"

### The Gospel: Luke 10:21-24

At that same hour Jesus rejoiced in the Holy Spirit and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and the intelligent and have revealed them to infants; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will. All things have been handed over to me by my Father; and no one knows who the Son is except the Father, or who the Father is except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him." Then turning to the disciples, Jesus said to them privately, "Blessed are the eyes that see what you see! For I tell you that many prophets and kings desired to see what you see, but did not see it. and to hear what you hear, but did not hear it."



### St. Samson the Hospitable - Feast Day: June 27

On June 27, the Church commemorates St. Samson the Hospitable, a saint whose life shines as a beacon of Christian compassion, selflessness, and healing. Living in the 6th century, St. Samson devoted himself to caring for the sick, the poor, and the homeless, using both his medical skills and his unwavering faith in Christ.

St. Samson was born into a noble and wealthy Roman family, either in Rome or Constantinople. From a young age, he received an outstanding education in both the liberal arts and the medical sciences. Yet, rather than using his knowledge and wealth to pursue power or luxury, Samson chose a life of simplicity and service. He saw his talents not as tools for self-advancement, but as gifts to be shared in service to others. After giving away his inheritance, Samson

dedicated his home to God's work.



He opened his doors to the poor and the sick, transforming his house into a place of refuge and healing. Those who were cast out, abandoned, or too poor to afford treatment found not only shelter under his roof but also dignity, compassion, and skilled medical care.

Samson's deep compassion and miraculous healing soon became known throughout the city. His most well-known encounter came when Emperor Justinian I himself fell gravely ill. None of the court physicians could cure him. Upon hearing of Samson's healing abilities, the emperor summoned him. With prayer and medicine, Samson healed the emperor. Grateful for this miraculous recovery, Justinian asked Samson what reward he would like. True to his selfless nature, Samson asked only that the emperor build a hospital for the poor and sick.

Justinian granted this request and built a large hospital near the Church of Hagia Sophia in Constantinople. Samson was placed in charge of this institution, and under his leadership, it became one of the greatest centers of Christian charity in the empire. The hospital offered free medical care to anyone in need, regardless of their status or wealth.

St. Samson's ministry was not limited to physical healing. His hospitality was rooted in Christ's command to love and serve the least among us. He ministered to the soul as well as the body, praying for his patients and comforting them with words of hope and salvation. His life is a living example of the Gospel in action.

St. Samson passed away peacefully in the 6th century, and his memory has been honored ever since. His life reminds us that every act of compassion, no matter how small, reflects the love of Christ. In a world that often overlooks the poor and sick, St. Samson challenges us to see Christ in those in need and to respond with love, generosity, and care.

As we commemorate his feast, may we be inspired by St. Samson's example to open the doors of our hearts and homes, offering healing, kindness, and hospitality to all who seek it.

St. Samson the Hospitable is considered the patron saint of hospitals, doctors and physicians, caregivers and nurses, hospice workers, the sick and infirm, homeless people and the poor, hospitality ministries.



Let us pray for persecuted Christians all over the world, especially in Syria after the bloody attack last Sunday which left 20 martyrs and dozens injured.


