# MISSION APPEAL JUNE 28/29 AT OUR LADY OF VICTORY PARISH

Next weekend at the 5:00 p.m. Mass on Saturday, and the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Masses on Sunday, we will have Fr. Sunder Ery from the Diocese Missionary office here at OLV to speak about the Diocese of Cuddapah, located in India. It is made up of 66 parishes catering to over 80,000 Catholics.

The mission appeal for the Diocese of Cuddapah serves a critical and urgent need, reflecting the essence of compassion, faith, and community support. Its purpose is multifaceted, addressing the unique challenges faced by the local Dalith community, predominantly comprising the Catholic population.

Addressing Poverty and Daily Struggles: The Diocese of Cuddapah is home to a significant Dalith population, who are mired in poverty. Around 90% of these Catholics struggle to make ends meet as unskilled daily laborers in the agricultural sector. Their hand-to-mouth existence is characterized by the inability to provide regular meals for themselves and their children. The mission appeal acknowledges their dire circumstances and seeks to alleviate their immediate suffering.

**Fostering Faith Formation and Empowering Through Education:** The mission appeal goes beyond immediate relief by offering free education to the first generation of children in these villages who are attending school. Education is a powerful tool for breaking the cycle of poverty.

**Building Community Spaces:** In addition to education and faith formation, the mission appeal recognizes the need for village chapels in certain mission stations. These chapels not only provide a sacred space for worship but also serve as a gathering place for various community activities and support networks. They strengthen the sense of unity and belonging among the local population, fostering a stronger community spirit.

In summary, the mission appeal for the Diocese of Cuddapah is driven by a deep sense of empathy and responsibility towards a marginalized and impoverished community. Its purpose is to provide essential support, education, and spiritual guidance to those who are struggling to make ends meet.





# **New Testament Reading: 1Corinthians 2:1-10**

When I came to you,

I did not come proclaiming the mystery of God to you in lofty words or wisdom.

For I decided to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and him crucified.

And I came to you in weakness and in fear and in much trembling.

My speech and my proclamation were not with plausible words of wisdom,

but with a demonstration of the Spirit and of power,

so that your faith might rest not on human wisdom but on the power of God.

Yet among the mature we do speak wisdom,

though it is not a wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age,

who are doomed to perish.

But we speak God's wisdom, secret and hidden,

which God decreed before the ages for our glory.

None of the rulers of this age understood this;

for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

But, as it is written,

"What no eye has seen, nor ear heard,

nor the human heart conceived,

what God has prepared for those who love him"

these things God has revealed to us through the Spirit;

for the Spirit searches everything,

even the depths of God.

# The Gospel: John 14:21-27

"They who have my commandments and keep them are those who love me;

and those who love me will be loved by my Father,

and I will love them and reveal myself to them."

Judas (not Iscariot) said to him,

"Lord, how is it that you will reveal yourself to us, and not to the world?"

Jesus answered him, "Those who love me will keep my word,

and my Father will love them, and we will come to them and make our home with them.

Whoever does not love me does not keep my words;

and the word that you hear is not mine, but is from the Father who sent me.

"I have said these things to you while I am still with you.

But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit,

whom the Father will send in my name,

will teach you everything,

and remind you of all that I have said to you.

Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you.

I do not give to you as the world gives.

Do not let your hearts be troubled,

and do not let them be afraid."

# Blessed Yaacub (Jacques) Haddad (1875-1954) - Feast Day: June 26

Blessed Yaacub Haddad, also known as "Abouna Yaacub," was a Capuchin priest from Lebanon who dedicated his life to the service of the poor, sick, and marginalized. He is remembered today as a man of great humility, deep prayer, and tireless charity.

Yaacub Haddad was born on February 1, 1875, in Ghazir, a village in the Mount Lebanon region. From a young age, Yaacub showed signs of piety and a deep love for God. He joined the Capuchin Franciscans, a branch of the Franciscan Order known for their simplicity and closeness to the people. He took the name Frère Yaacub de Ghazir, reflecting both his religious commitment and his love for his hometown.

He was ordained a priest in 1901 and quickly became known for his spiritual wisdom and compassion.

Living during a time of political upheaval and great poverty in Lebanon and the Middle East, Fr. Yaacub became a beacon of hope to those suffering. He devoted himself especially to the poor and the sick, seeing in them the face of Christ.



Throughout his ministry, he built schools, hospitals, and orphanages, most notably founding the Congregation of the Franciscan Sisters of the Cross of Lebanon in 1930. This religious community of women continues to serve in education, health care, and charitable work throughout the Middle East. His dream was to create a Lebanese expression of Franciscan love in action — a local Church response to real human need, rooted in the Gospel.

Fr. Yaacub was known for his powerful preaching, calling people to repentance, forgiveness, and trust in Divine Providence. He spent countless hours in the confessional and visiting the sick, often walking long distances to reach those in need. His presence brought peace and his words touched hearts.

He was also a man of intense prayer, frequently spending long hours in Eucharistic adoration. His deep devotion to the Passion of Christ and the Virgin Mary fueled his service and gave him strength, even in times of great difficulty. He lived a life of poverty and detachment, relying completely on God for all his works.

Blessed Yaacub died on June 26, 1954, in Beirut. His funeral was attended by people from all walks of life, a testament to the widespread love and admiration he had earned. His tomb in the Motherhouse of the Franciscan Sisters in Jal el-Dib, Lebanon, has become a site of pilgrimage.

On June 22, 2008, Pope Benedict XVI beatified Yaacub in Beirut, recognizing his heroic virtues and confirming his reputation for holiness. He is now venerated as Blessed Yaacub of Ghazir, the first Lebanese Capuchin to be beatified.

Blessed Yaacub's legacy lives on through the continued work of the Franciscan Sisters of the Cross and the many lives he inspired. His life reminds us that holiness is possible in every time and place – through love, service, and trust in God.


