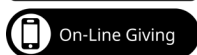

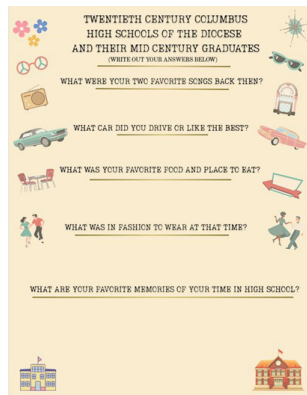
PLEASE NOTE – CANDLE OFFERINGS IN CHURCH:

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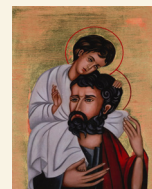
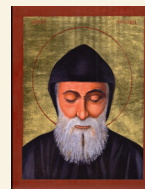

New Testament Reading: 2 Corinthians 3:1-6

Are we beginning to commend ourselves again?

Surely we do not need, as some do, letters of recommendation to you or from you, do we?

You yourselves are our letter, written on our hearts, to be known and read by all;

and you show that you are a letter of Christ, prepared by us,

written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God,

not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts.

Such is the confidence that we have through Christ toward God.

Not that we are competent of ourselves to claim anything as coming from us;

our competence is from God, who has made us competent to be ministers of a new covenant,

not of letter but of spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

The Gospel: Luke 10:1-7

After this the Lord appointed seventy others and sent them on ahead of him in pairs to every town and place where he himself intended to go.

He said to them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few;

therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.

Go on your way.

See, I am sending you out like lambs into the midst of wolves.

Carry no purse, no bag, no sandals; and greet no one on the road.

Whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house!'

And if anyone is there who shares in peace, your peace will rest on that person;

but if not, it will return to you.

Remain in the same house, eating and drinking whatever they provide,

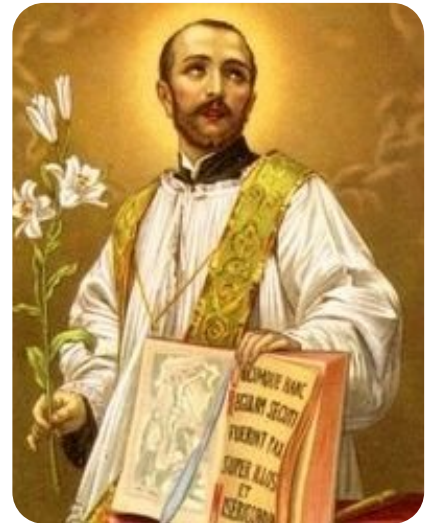
for the laborer deserves to be paid.

Do not move about from house to house.

Saint Anthony Mary Zaccaria - Feast day: July 5

On July 5, the Church honors Saint Anthony Mary Zaccaria, a priest, physician, and reformer whose brief life left a lasting impact on the Church. Though he lived only thirty-six years, his zeal for Christ, devotion to the Eucharist, and commitment to renewing the spiritual life of the faithful continue to inspire Catholics today.

Anthony Mary Zaccaria was born in Cremona, Italy, in 1502. His father died when he was still an infant, leaving his mother, Antonia Pescaroli, to raise him. She was a woman of deep faith who devoted herself to her son's spiritual and moral formation. Through her example, Anthony learned the importance of prayer, charity, and trust in God.



As a young man, Anthony pursued studies in medicine at the University of Padua. After completing his education, he returned to Cremona and began practicing as a physician. Yet he soon realized that while medicine could heal the body, many people were suffering spiritually. He felt called to dedicate his life to healing souls as well as bodies.

After prayer and discernment, Anthony began studying for the priesthood and was ordained in 1528. From the beginning of his ministry, he became known for his passionate preaching and concern for the spiritual welfare of the people. He encouraged frequent reception of the sacraments and urged Christians to develop a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ.

At a time when many parts of the Church were experiencing spiritual decline, Anthony recognized the need for renewal. He believed that true reform begins not with structures or programs but with a conversion of the heart. He called people to return to the Gospel and to place Christ at the center of their lives.

To support this mission, Anthony founded a religious congregation known as the Clerics Regular of Saint Paul, more commonly called the Barnabites because they were associated with the Church of Saint Barnabas in Milan. The Barnabites focused on preaching, education, and spiritual renewal. He also helped establish communities for women and laypeople who desired to deepen their Christian faith while remaining active in the world.

One of Saint Anthony's greatest contributions was his promotion of devotion to the Holy Eucharist. He encouraged the faithful to spend time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament and emphasized the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. He is often credited with helping spread the practice of public Eucharistic adoration and encouraging church bells to ring on Fridays at three o'clock in the afternoon, reminding Christians of Christ's death on the cross.

Anthony had a profound devotion to the Passion of Christ. He taught that meditation on the suffering and sacrifice of Jesus helps believers grow in love, humility, and gratitude. His preaching often challenged people to move beyond routine religious practice and to embrace a vibrant, living faith.

Although his work was fruitful, it was not always easy. Some misunderstood his efforts and criticized his reforms. Yet Anthony remained steadfast, trusting that God would guide his mission. His humility and perseverance became powerful examples for those around him.

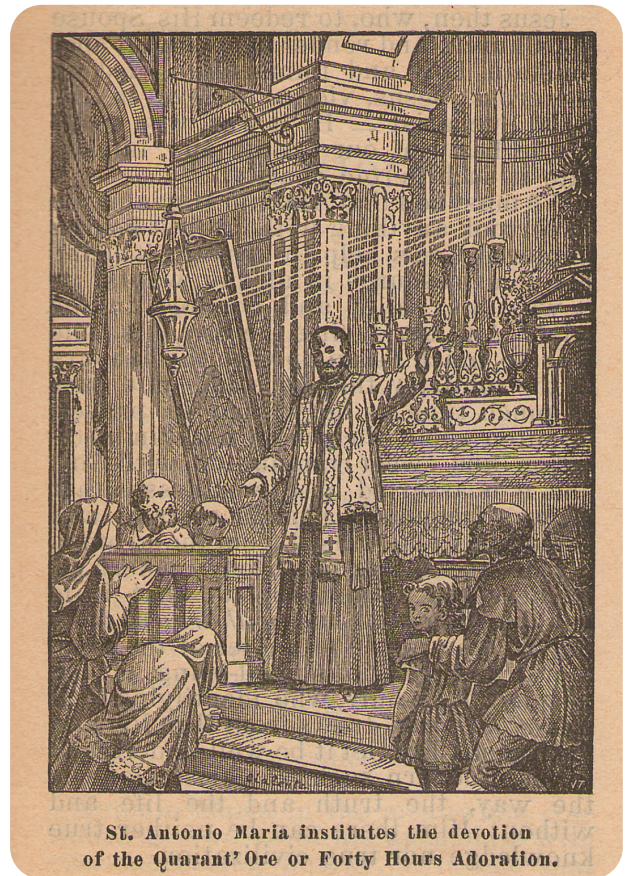
Exhausted from constant travel, preaching, and ministry, Anthony's health began to decline. In 1539, he returned to his hometown of Cremona, where he died at the age of thirty-six. Before his death, he encouraged his followers to remain faithful to Christ and continue the work of spiritual renewal.

Saint Anthony Mary Zaccaria was canonized in 1897 by Pope Leo XIII. Today, he is remembered as a courageous reformer who sought to renew the Church through prayer, holiness, and devotion to the Eucharist. His life reminds us that every Christian is called to grow closer to Christ and to help bring spiritual renewal to the world.

As we celebrate his feast day on July 5, may Saint Anthony Mary Zaccaria inspire us to deepen our love for the Eucharist, embrace the Gospel with renewed enthusiasm, and become faithful witnesses of Christ in our daily lives.

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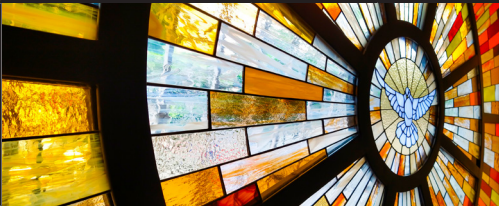
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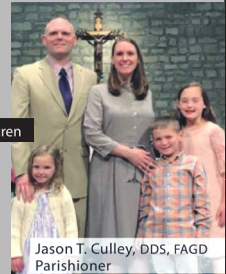
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
