New Testament Reading: Philippians 3:7-14

Whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ.
More than that,

I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.

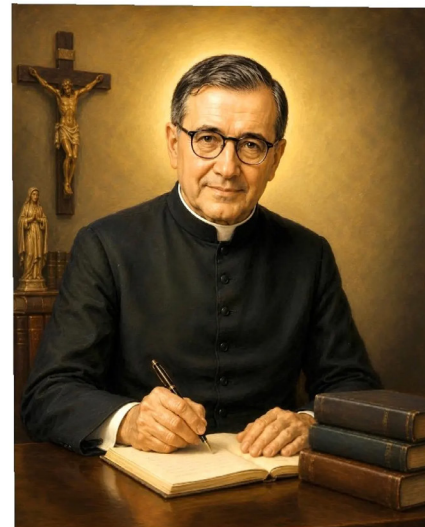
The Gospel: Matthew 10:1-7

Jesus summoned his twelve disciples
and gave them authority over unclean spirits,
to cast them out,
and to cure every disease and every sickness.
These are the names of the twelve apostles:
first, Simon, also known as Peter,
and his brother Andrew;
James son of Zebedee, and his brother John;
Philip and Bartholomew;
Thomas and Matthew the tax collector;
James son of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus;
Simon the Cananaean,
and Judas Iscariot, the one who betrayed him.
These twelve Jesus sent out with the following instructions:
“Go nowhere among the Gentiles,
and enter no town of the Samaritans,
but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.
As you go, proclaim the good news,
‘The kingdom of heaven has come near.’”

Saint Josemaría Escrivá – Feast Day: June 26

On June 26, the Catholic Church celebrates the feast of St. Josemaría Escrivá, a priest whose message transformed the spiritual lives of countless people around the world. Through his teachings and example, he reminded the faithful that holiness is not reserved for priests, religious sisters, or missionaries. Rather, every baptized Christian is called to become a saint through the ordinary circumstances of daily life.

Josemaría Escrivá was born on January 9, 1902, in Barbastro, Spain. He grew up in a loving Catholic family and experienced both joy and hardship during his youth. After the death of several siblings and financial difficulties that affected his family, Josemaría learned to trust in God's providence and mercy.



As a teenager, he felt called to the priesthood and was ordained in 1925. During his early years as a priest, he devoted himself to serving the poor, the sick, and those in need. He spent long hours hearing confessions, celebrating Mass, and accompanying people in their spiritual lives. Yet he sensed that God was calling him to a special mission.

On October 2, 1928, during a time of prayer and retreat, Josemaría received the inspiration that would lead to the founding of Opus Dei, which means “The Work of God.” He understood that God was calling ordinary men and women to seek holiness in their everyday responsibilities. Whether one was a teacher, farmer, student, parent, businessperson, or laborer, daily work could become a path to sanctity when offered to God with love.

This message was revolutionary for many people. At a time when holiness was often associated primarily with monasteries and convents, St. Josemaría emphasized that family life, professional work, friendships, and ordinary duties could all become opportunities to grow closer to Christ. He taught that every task, no matter how small, could be sanctified through prayer, excellence, and love.

Throughout his life, St. Josemaría encouraged Catholics to develop a deep relationship with Jesus through daily prayer, frequent reception of the Eucharist, devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and regular participation in the sacramental life of the Church. He believed that holiness is achieved not through extraordinary acts but through faithfulness in the small duties of each day.

The Spanish Civil War brought great suffering and danger to the Church. During this difficult period, Josemaría remained steadfast in his faith and continued his ministry despite significant risks. After the war, the work of Opus Dei spread throughout Spain and eventually across the world.

St. Josemaría spent the remainder of his life preaching the universal call to holiness. He traveled extensively, meeting people from all walks of life and encouraging them to discover God's presence in their homes, workplaces, and communities. His simple but profound message resonated with million

He died suddenly on June 26, 1975, in Rome. His reputation for holiness continued to grow, and Pope St. John Paul II canonized him on October 6, 2002. In his homily for the canonization, the Pope praised St. Josemaría's conviction that ordinary life is the place where Christians encounter God and fulfill their vocation.

Today, St. Josemaría's message remains as relevant as ever. In a world that often separates faith from daily life, he reminds us that God is present in our homes, offices, schools, and neighborhoods. Every task performed with love, every act of service, and every moment offered to God can become a step toward holiness.

As we celebrate his feast day, may we ask St. Josemaría Escrivá to help us recognize God's presence in our daily lives and to strive for holiness in all that we do.

St. Josemaría Escrivá, you taught that every Christian is called to holiness through ordinary work and daily duties. Pray for us, that we may serve God faithfully in our homes, workplaces, and communities, and grow each day in love for Christ. Amen.

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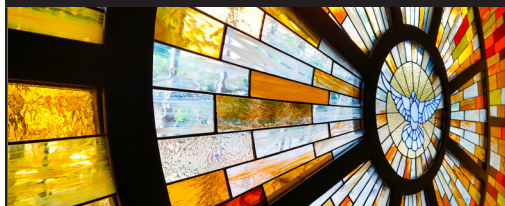
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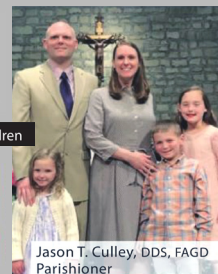
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
