

<u>Registration will begin online August 11th.</u> The Registration Link and information will be emailed to you as well as posted on the OLV Website. *PLEASE* register ASAP so you can reserve your child's spot in their class. **If you are new to the parish, you need to be a REGISTERED** member of OLV for your children to attend Religious Education. Contact Krista Joseph to begin the registration process.

<u>Please remember</u> that our <u>First Communion Program is a 2-YEAR program</u> with preparation <u>beginning in 1st Grade</u> – It is required that your child attend 1st Grade in order to make their First Communion in 2nd Grade. Our <u>Confirmation Program is also a 2-YEAR program</u> with preparation <u>beginning in 7th Grade</u> and Confirmation in 8th Grade.

**If your child did not attend class last year in 1st or 7th grade, please contact Krista ASAP so she can arrange for your child to get caught up to receive their Sacraments on time.

Our PreK Class is limited to 16 Children and those spots fill up fast! Please see our website for information describing all the programs at OLV.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN CLASS AT OLV





Eric is an award-winning songwriter and creator and host of Songs at the Center, which graces over 400 stations nationwide!


Tony Arata was born in Savannah, GA and grew up on nearby Tybee Island. While studying for a journalism degree from Georgia Southern University, he began performing his original songs in local bands. In 1986, he and his wife Jaymi moved


to Nashville where his unique, soulful style began to get the attention of people like Allen Reynolds and Garth Brooks. Garth, to date, has recorded seven of Tony's songs, and "The Dance" won Song of the Year at The Academy of Country Music and received both a Country Music Association and a Grammy nomination, as well as a most-performed song in Radio and Records Magazine.

Tony is a member of the Nashville Songwriters Hall of Fame (2012). He has also had No. 1 records with "Here I Am" for Patty Loveless, "I'm Holding My Own" for Lee Roy Parnell, and "Dreaming With My Eyes Open" for Clay Walker. Other artists who have recorded his songs include Dolly Parton, Emmylou Harris, Bonnie Raitt, Trisha Yearwood, Delbert McClinton, Don Williams, Reba McEntire, Suzy Bogguss, and Hal Ketchum. Tony has also recorded four solo albums featuring new songs, covers, and guest appearances by many of Nashville's finest musicians as well as folks who have recorded his songs, including Garth, Patty, and Lee Roy.

New Testament Reading: Ephesians 2:17-22

So he came and proclaimed peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near; for through him both of us have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling place for God.

The Gospel: Luke 19:1-10

Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through it.

A man was there named Zacchaeus;

he was a chief tax collector and was rich.

He was trying to see who Jesus was,

but on account of the crowd he could not,

St. Rose of Lima - Feast Day: Aug. 23



On August 23, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Rose of Lima, the first canonized saint of the Americas. Born Isabel Flores de Oliva in Lima, Peru, in 1586, she was nicknamed "Rose" by her family after a servant saw her face miraculously transformed into a beautiful rose. This name suited her, for her life would become a fragrant offering to Christ.

From her earliest years, Rose showed an extraordinary devotion to God. She fasted regularly, spent long hours in prayer, and cultivated a deep love for the Blessed Sacrament. Inspired by the life of St. Catherine of Siena, she took a vow of perpetual virginity at a young age, choosing Christ as her only spouse. Her parents hoped she would marry, but Rose felt strongly that God was calling her to a different life.

Although she longed to join a convent, her family's financial situation required her to remain at home. Rose embraced this as part of God's plan. She transformed her small bedroom into a place of prayer and penance, wearing a crown of thorns hidden under flowers and practicing fasting as a form of self-discipline. These sacrifices were not acts of self-punishment, but rather ways for Rose to unite her sufferings with Christ's for the salvation of souls.

Rose also served the poor with great tenderness. To help her family, she grew flowers and did needlework, selling them in the market. She used much of her earnings to care for those in need, nursing the sick and helping the hungry. Her compassion and humility became well known in Lima. Many sought her prayers, convinced that God listened closely to her.

At age 20, Rose became a member of the Third Order of St. Dominic, allowing her to live a consecrated life at home. She continued her intense prayer life, often spending entire nights before the Blessed Sacrament. Witnesses later testified to her extraordinary mystical gifts, including visions of Christ and Mary. Despite these favors, Rose never sought attention — she wanted only to glorify God.

Her life was not without suffering. She endured misunderstanding, illness, and spiritual trials. Yet through it all, she remained joyful, trusting entirely in God's providence. Rose once said, "Apart from the cross, there is no other ladder by which we may get to heaven."

St. Rose of Lima died on August 24, 1617, at just 31 years old. The entire city of Lima mourned her passing, and miracles were reported at her tomb. Pope Clement X canonized her in 1671, declaring her patroness of Peru, the Americas, and the Philippines. She is also the patron saint of florists and gardeners, embroidery workers, and those ridiculed for their piety.

St. Rose's life reminds us that holiness is not reserved for priests or religious alone. She showed that in the midst of daily life—working, caring for family, and helping neighbors—we can grow close to Christ. Her love for the poor, her devotion to prayer, and her willingness to suffer for the sake of others remain powerful examples for all Christians today.

As we celebrate St. Rose of Lima, let us ask for her intercession, that we too may live lives of prayer, generosity, and faithful love for God.


