New Testament Reading: Ephesians 1:15-23

I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints,
and for this reason I do not cease to give thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers.
I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory,
may give you a spirit of wisdom and revelation
as you come to know him,
so that, with the eyes of your heart enlightened,
you may know what is the hope to which he has called you,
what are the riches of his glorious inheritance among the saints,
and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power
for us who believe,
according to the working of his great power.
God put this power to work in Christ
when he raised him from the dead
and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly places,
far above all rule and authority and power and dominion,
and above every name that is named,
not only in this age but also in the age to come.

and has made him the head over all things for the church,
which is his body,

Saint Dymphna - Feast Day: May 15

Saint Dymphna is venerated as a young Christian martyr and a powerful intercessor for those suffering from mental and emotional distress. Though the historical details of her life are limited, tradition holds that she lived in the 7th century and was the daughter of a pagan Irish king. Her story, preserved through oral accounts and later written sources, has inspired devotion for centuries, particularly among those seeking healing and peace of mind.

According to tradition, Dymphna's mother was a devout Christian who raised her daughter in the faith. After her mother's death, Dymphna's father fell into deep grief and instability. In his anguish, he sought a woman who resembled his late wife and, tragically, became fixated on his own daughter. Determined to remain faithful to her Christian values and her vow of chastity, Dymphna fled Ireland. She was accompanied by her confessor, Saint Gerebernus, and they eventually settled in what is now Geel.



For a time, Dymphna lived quietly, dedicating herself to prayer and acts of charity. However, her father eventually tracked her down. When she refused to return with him or submit to his demands, he ordered the death of Gerebernus and ultimately killed Dymphna himself. She is believed to have been only about 15 years old at the time of her martyrdom. Her courage and steadfast faith in the face of fear and violence have made her a model of purity, resilience, and trust in God.

Dymphna's cult quickly spread in the region of Geel, where she was buried. Over time, reports of healings—especially of those suffering from mental illness—began to emerge. By the Middle Ages, the town had become a place of pilgrimage. A unique tradition developed in Geel, where families would take individuals with mental illness into their homes, offering them care, dignity, and inclusion. This compassionate model of community care continues in various forms even today and is often cited as a remarkable example of faith lived through hospitality.

The feast day of Saint Dymphna is celebrated on **May 15**. On this day, the Church honors her witness and asks for her intercession, particularly for those struggling with anxiety, depression, trauma, and other mental health challenges. Many parishes and communities mark the occasion with special prayers, novenas, or Mass intentions for healing and support.

Saint Dymphna is best known as the patron saint of those afflicted with mental and emotional disorders, as well as of caregivers, counselors, and psychologists.

She is also invoked by victims of abuse and those who feel lost, overwhelmed, or alone. Her story resonates deeply in today's world, where mental health concerns are increasingly recognized as an important part of overall well-being. Through her example, the faithful are reminded of the importance of compassion, understanding, and the dignity of every human person.

In art, Saint Dymphna is often depicted holding a sword (symbolizing her martyrdom) and sometimes accompanied by a demon being restrained, representing her role in spiritual and mental healing. Churches, shrines, and ministries dedicated to her continue to offer hope to many who seek her intercession.

As we remember Saint Dymphna, we are invited to pray not only for those in need of healing but also for greater awareness and kindness in our communities. Her life, though brief, speaks powerfully of faith, courage, and the healing love of God.

Saint Dymphna, patroness of those suffering from anxiety, emotional illness, and distress, pray for us. Grant comfort and peace to all who struggle in mind, body, or spirit.

Help them to know the healing love of Christ and the support of those who care for them. Pray also for families, caregivers, counselors, and all who bring hope to others in times of suffering.

*Saint Dymphna, give us courage, peace of mind, and trust in God's mercy.


