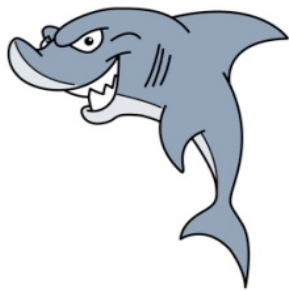

Designed by Dave Thomas and Peter Alliss, the majestic fairways and carpet-smooth greens of The Brabazon form a world-famous stage on which some of golf's most exhilarating dramas have played out.

Legendary in the world of golf, and the spiritual home of the Ryder Cup, the Brabazon's perilous bunkers and lakes have tested some of the greatest players including Ballesteros, Woods and Faldo.

Yardage: 7,053

With its inland links appearance, this championship golf course presents a unique challenge thanks to harder and faster running fairways, quicker, wide open undulating greens, more severe run-offs and its cavernous bunkers, with faces up to 15ft in height.

The PGA National is fast becoming one of the top courses in the country, having hosted two European Tour Events.
