01 Personal Essentials

Daily necessities that support health, hygiene and personal well-being.

EXAMPLES

- Soap, toothpaste and deodorant
- Razors and feminine hygiene products
- Socks, towels and backpacks
- Personal-care supplies

ACCEPTANCE STANDARD

New, unopened, unexpired and appropriate for direct distribution.



02 Clothing & Seasonal Gear

Clean, serviceable clothing for daily life, employment and changing weather.

EXAMPLES

- Everyday clothing and jackets
- Boots and professional attire
- Cold-weather gear
- Rain gear

ACCEPTANCE STANDARD

Clean, odor-free, serviceable and ready to wear. No torn, stained or heavily worn items.



03 Household Essentials

Practical household goods that help turn housing into a functional home.

EXAMPLES

- Dishes, cookware and coffee makers
- Microwaves and small appliances
- Cleaning supplies and storage containers
- Lamps and organization items

ACCEPTANCE STANDARD

Clean, complete and fully functional. Electrical items must operate safely and include all necessary parts.



04 Furniture

Functional furniture that is clean, stable and suitable for continued use.

EXAMPLES

- Beds, dressers and tables
- Chairs and bookshelves
- Nightstands and couches
- Desks

ACCEPTANCE STANDARD

Structurally sound, clean and free from odors, pests, major damage or missing hardware. Advance approval is required.
