COOPERATIVES in California

Agricultural cooperatives are organized to help farmers gain market power by joining together to market their crops, increase their bargaining power by achieving economies of scale, processing their commodity to add value, and/or to purchase supplies and services.



Marketing, service, and supply cooperatives are the most common types of agricultural cooperatives organized in the U.S.



Owned by farmer-members.

Democratically controlled by the farmers who own and use the business.

Economic benefits are distributed to members on the basis of the member's use of the cooperative.

Provide benefits to producer-members as users, not as invetors.
