No-Dig must be 3' deep. - Use galvanized pipe, donuts, U-posts, or IPosts.

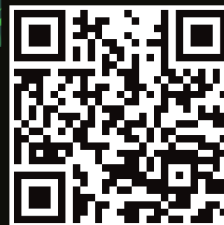

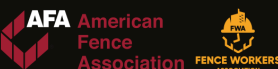
