December 7th Christmas Parade Guidelines 2024

Parade Theme: "Home for the Holidays"

Setup/Parade start time: Set-up time is 3:00pm on Saturday, December 7th. Parade begins at 5:00pm.

<u>Setup location:</u> The Parking Lot at Clay St. & Washington St. (Enter from Clay St.) **Only one person from your** group needs to check in to get the instructions and your Parade #.

Rain Date: None – The parade will be canceled if the weather is bad.

<u>Parade Route:</u> The parade route begins at Second and School streets, travels East on Second, right (south) on Brown, then right (west) on Third back to School Street. Judging takes place on Third near Coombs.

NO Candy Throwing: Candy CANNOT be thrown from vehicles. Please have walkers who can "HAND OUT" treats to avoid children scrambling for thrown items and possibly getting injured. This is A MUST! If we see you group throwing out candy, you could be disqualified from the Judges.

<u>Adult supervision:</u> All entries that include minors are required to have adults present to assist with setup and supervision of children.

 $\underline{\textbf{Animals:}} \text{ If you have animals in the parade, you } \underline{\textbf{MUST CLEAN-UP}} \text{ any mess during the parade, } \underline{\textbf{not after!}}$

<u>Santa:</u> Will be at the NV Welcome Center after the parade, located at 1300 1st St.#313 in Downtown Napa. <u>Please, ONLY ONE Santa can appear in the parade</u>. The Parade Organizers have arranged for Santa's appearance.

<u>Decorating tips:</u> We suggest and encourage using lights to decorate your float.

Entry Fee: Entry in the parade is **FREE** for all participants.

Judging: Prizes will be awarded in the following **Categories**:

Most or Best use of Lights \$500
Best Theme Entry "Home for the Holidays") \$500
Best Music – make some noise! \$500
