

THE CPMC HUT BOOKING PROCESS AND RULES

Bookings

Please book online (<u>capeprovincemountainclub.com</u>), to reserve your dates. Please complete and submit the attached hut booking form to (<u>capeprovincemountainclub@gmail.com</u>). To confirm the booking, you will need to pay a deposit of 50% of the invoice and submit your proof of payment. Your dates will then be confirmed. Payment must be made within 48 hours of requesting a booking.

Cancellations are allowed up to 72 hours prior to the reservation date, failing which you will forfeit 50% of your deposit. Deposits are not refundable but may be used for a later booking. Outstanding amounts are due 48 hours prior to the reservation date.

Maximum capacity is 20 people (Covid rules apply where applicable).

Keys will be available for collection 24 hours prior to your booking and must be returned within 24 hours of your booking.

Costs

Adult member	R60 per night
Adult non-member	R125 per night
Non-member children 5yrs and over	R50 per night
Wood	R40 per bag
Charcoal	R55 per bag
Firelighters	R15 per box
Chaperone for non-members	R500
Breakage deposit (refundable)	R500

Note:

Children older than 16 years old are viewed as adults. Children younger than 5 years old do not pay any fees.

You may not use your own firelighters, wood or charcoal. These must be purchased from the CPMC.

General rules of use

1. Kitchen

All cooking (including braai) must be done in the kitchen area. No cooking is to be done in the living area.

We provide biodegradable products in the kitchen and disposable "All purpose" cloth rolls. Please do not use any other detergents.

We provide cutlery, crockery, pots and pans for use. An inventory is available, please ensure you leave all items in clean and packed.

There are braai tongs and braai grid cleaning brushes in the kitchen.

Please note - cloths used must be removed from hut.

2. Mattresses

All mattresses are stored on a bed or a deck. Mattresses must not be moved. Please ensure that mattresses are wiped cleaned should they be messed.

3. Toilet

We provide biodegradable toilet paper. There are extra rolls provided in the dispenser, should you require additional rolls these are available in the hut.

Please only use the biodegradable toilet paper in our eco-loo and no other objects to be thrown in toilet.

4. Fires and ash

Fires must only be made in the designated areas. No fires are allowed outside of the hut. Charcoal must only be used in the braai.

Wood and splitting wood axe are located in the entrance area of the hut. No wood must be split inside the living area or kitchen.

The braai and fireplace must be cleaned before leaving the hut. Ash must only be placed in the ash box situated in the living area.

5. Cleanliness

Please ensure that you clean all areas of the hut prior to leaving.

All areas must be swept.

All surfaces must be washed clean.

Do not leave any of your items in the hut. This includes pillows, sheets and sleeping bags. There are no storage areas for your personal items.

All food and leftovers must be removed from the hut. We recommend closing all food at night.

No writing on the walls or furniture is permitted, this includes cravings, graffiti or any other markings.

NO DIRT MUST BE LEFT AT HUT. PLEASE ENSURE ALL DIRT IS CARRIED DOWN.

Note: The hut is not to be used for commercial purposes. It is intended for use by members of the public to experience Table Mountain.
