Follow signs towards Rt 101 West (Bedford-Milford) / AK9C is located on Rt. 101, approximately 6 miles from the Rt. 114 interchange. *** AK9C is on the right - 2 miles after Murphy's Taproom, across from Camp Road at the blinking yellow light.

FROM THE SOUTH (Boston) - North to Manchester I-293 to 101 West / Follow signs towards 101 West (Bedford-Milford). See *** above.

FROM THE NORTH (Concord) - South to I-293 toward 101 West. Follow signs towards 101 West (Bedford-Milford). See *** above.

HOW DOES MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR Fast CAT?

The time of the dog's run is converted to miles per hour (MPH) and then multiplied by a handicap based on the dog's height at the withers to award points.

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Under 12" = Handicap is 2.0

FORMULA: $\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$



Titles are earned by accumulating points. The following titles will be awarded: BCAT =150 points; DCAT = 500 points; FCAT = 1,000 points; and FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points. These suffix titles will appear on a dog's pedigree, with a higher-level title superseding a lower-level title.

Top 20 by Breed by Year

The AKC Fast CAT website features the Top 20 fastest dogs by breed for each year. Dogs must complete at least 3 qualifying runs in each calendar year to qualify for the Top 20. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat_ranking.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBLE DOGS: Fast CAT is open to dogs 12 months of age or older. All dogs must be individually registered with the AKC including purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), and AKC Canine Partners. Spayed or neutered dogs, or dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: No entry fee will be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or banned from competition by the action of the trial committee. Any entries pulled in writing (email/mail) prior to entry closing will be refunded. Any entries pulled after closing will not be refunded.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

1. Entries will NOT be accepted without fees, signatures on the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
2. Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. All dogs will be inspected. Bitches in season, lame, overweight, or out of condition dogs will be refused entry at inspection. A refund (minus AKC recording fee) will be given for dogs refused entry. An owner can substitute another of their own dogs if a dog is not allowed due to BIS, injury, or being unfit.
3. This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs, and water.
4. Electronic, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of a white plastic bag. Backup equipment will be available.
5. Run order will be based on pre-signup order set by the field committee.
6. **Effective November 2022, there are no boomerang/recalls. A handler cannot recall their dog from the startline.**
7. No flexi leads, pinch collars, electronic training collars or devices allowed. A plain buckle collar and lead is recommended. Dogs are allowed to run with no collar – however, a dog that cannot be caught for an excessive amount of time (causing a delay in the event) may be assessed a \$10.00 fine.
8. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
9. The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
10. Any decisions made by the event's officials regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the event officials to withhold any and all qualifications.
11. Persons exhibiting un-sportsman like conduct or conduct detrimental to the club or any dog(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the event site.
12. Dogs engaged with the lure but not completing the 100-yard course will be excused for that test.
13. Dogs not on course must be on leash and under control at all times.
14. There will be a minimum \$30 returned check charge.
15. Children must be accompanied by an adult and under supervision at all times.
16. Only the Lure Operator, Huntmaster, and Handler of the dog running the trial will be permitted near the lure machine.

SCHEDULE

Tests will be held concurrently using a block schedule running order. NO Open RUN ORDER. Once entries close, a link will be emailed to sign up for a time block. Anyone who does not self-sign up for a time block TWO DAYS PRIOR to the event will be ASSIGNED a block by the Club. ****You MUST run during your specified TIME BLOCK ONLY**.**

Tests will begin promptly at 8:00 AM and will continue until all registered runs are completed. Check in is required 30 minutes prior to your time block run time.

There will be no on-site trial briefing. It is the responsibility of each entrant to be ready when their dog is called to the line. Be sure that you have a catcher and your catcher has a leash. Approximately 25 dogs will be scheduled to run each hour. Once all your runs are completed, PLEASE leave the grounds to allow adequate parking for the next hour competitors.

CHECK IN AND INSPECTION

Check In will occur on a rolling basis throughout the day. The two Fast CAT Tests each day will be run CONCURRENTLY, so a dog entered in both Tests will run twice within your time block. Exhibitors will select their time slot, please arrive approximately 30 minutes before the run time. Check In is then immediately followed by Inspection for fitness, lameness, or "in season" females. Each female dog will be inspected. The dog owner will be required to wipe the dog with tissue to show the dog is not in season.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.

Bitches in season, lame and/or unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. Please do not bring bitches in season to the test.
