As we continue recovering from the effects of Hurricane Helene last September, we wanted to take a moment to thank everyone who has already worked so hard to clean up and restore their properties. It's been a challenging time for many, and the strength of our community really shines through in moments like these.

We've recently received confirmation that the county will no longer be providing additional clean-up services, which means it's now up to each of us as homeowners to take care of any remaining storm debris, trash, or yard waste on our properties.

As a reminder, our neighborhood covenants do require all homeowners to maintain their yards in a neat and tidy condition, free of any unsightly debris or clutter. This includes storm debris from downed trees (branches, wood piles, leaf piles, and large unsightly stumps) as well as debris from other property damage (fences, siding, roofing materials, and other general debris) This helps preserve the beauty of our neighborhood and supports everyone's property values.

If you still have storm-related materials in your yard, please make arrangements for the complete removal as soon as possible. If you're in need of assistance or would like help coordinating with a local service provider, feel free to reach out to the HOA Board - we're happy to share resources or recommendations.
