There are two important Christian days of celebration during May this year. On the 18th is Ascension Day, 40 days after Easter marking the day that Christ ascended to heaven to sit on the Father's right hand. He promised us a gift and intermediary, the Holy Spirit. From my boyhood church in Gainesville Holy Trinity, the one surviving window (it had been removed for restoration) following the 1990 fire that razed the 1908 church is on the east wall of the Sancturary depicting Christ ascending flanked by two angels.

The second day of celebration is ten days later known as the Day of Pentecost. This marks the occasion when the disciples and new followers were sequestered in the Upper Room and the Holy Spirit came upon them as fire from heaven. At St. Mary's, we have a wonderful stained glass window on the south side that depicts this in art and word, "Come Holy Spirit."


