✓ 1. Ask: "How Does This Truth Change My Life?"

 - How does this impact my decisions?

✓ 2. Pray for Transformation, Not Just Information

📖 Psalm 119:18

"Open my eyes, that I may behold wondrous things out of Your law."

✓ 3. Live What You Preach

📖 Titus 2:7

"Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works."

- ✓ People don't just listen to **what you say**—they watch **how you live**.

✓ 4. Surround Yourself with People Who Challenge You to Grow

📖 Proverbs 27:17

"Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another."

- ✓ Stay connected to a **community of believers** who apply their faith.
