# **Disciplemaking in 5 Minutes**

## The Call to Multiply

Jesus didn't just call us to believe—He called us to *make disciples*. It's not optional. It's the mission. But disciplemaking isn't about complicated programs or years of training. It starts with intentional moments, real conversations, and a commitment to walk with others. You have five minutes—here's how to use them to build the kingdom.

## Step 1: Connect & Invest (1 Minute)

Discipleship starts with relationship. People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care.

#### **how to Start:**

- Be intentional: Text someone and check in.
- Show up: Ask about their life, struggles, and faith journey.
- Pray for them—even if they don't know it yet.

## **Example Message:**

"Hey man, I was thinking about you today. How's life? Anything I can pray for?"

## Step 2: Share Truth (2 Minutes)

Discipleship is about pointing people to Jesus, not just offering life advice. Keep it simple, keep it Scripture-centered.

#### Truth to Share:

- **Jesus is enough** Colossians 2:6-7 (Stay rooted in Him.)
- **Grace over guilt** *Romans 8:1* (No condemnation in Christ.)
- Faith requires action James 1:22 (Be doers, not just hearers.)

#### Example Conversation:

"I know you're struggling, but remember—God's grace is bigger than our failures. Romans 8:1 says there's no condemnation for those in Christ. Keep pressing forward."

## Step 3: Challenge & Encourage (1 Minute)

Discipleship isn't just comfort—it's accountability. Push people to take real steps of faith.

### Challenge Questions:

- "What's one thing God's been teaching you?"
- "How can I help you take your next step in faith?"
- "What's stopping you from sharing this with someone else?"

### **b** Example Message:

"I challenge you this week—read James 1 and tell me your biggest takeaway. Let's sharpen each other."

## Step 4: Repeat & Multiply (1 Minute)

Discipleship isn't just about growing yourself—it's about raising up others to do the same.

## Next Steps:

- Challenge them to disciple someone else.
- Equip them with resources (books, podcasts, Scripture).
- Keep showing up—discipleship is a *journey*, not a one-time event.

• Final Challenge: "Who are you pouring into? Who's pouring into you? Let's build the kingdom together."

## Final Thought: Just Start

You don't need a perfect plan. You don't need all the answers. You just need to show up, share truth, and walk with people toward Jesus. The world needs more disciple-makers. The mission is clear. Are you in?
