Disciplemaking in 5 Minutes

The Mission Goes Online

Jesus didn't limit discipleship to face-to-face encounters where He was at—He met people where they were. Today, where are people? Online. Social media isn't just for scrolling—it's a mission field. In five minutes, you can encourage, equip, and challenge someone to walk deeper with Christ. Here's how to disciple-make in the digital space.

Step 1: Connect with Intentionality (1 Minute)

Discipleship starts with *showing up*. Online, this means reaching out, commenting, and engaging with real purpose.

How to Start:

- DM someone and ask, "How's your faith journey going?"
- Drop a thoughtful reply on their post, not just a generic emoji.
- Start a group chat or online Bible study.

Example Message:

Truth to Share:

- **Trusting God** *Proverbs 3:5-6* (Lean on Him, not yourself.)
- Faith in action James 2:17 (Faith moves, it doesn't sit still.)

Example Post or DM:

"Feeling lost? Remember, Jesus didn't just die to save you—He rose to give you purpose. You're not an accident. (Ephesians 2:10)"

Best Platforms:

- Instagram/TikTok Short, engaging videos or reels.
- **Twitter/X** Quick, thought-provoking challenges.
- Facebook Groups Great for deeper discussions.
- YouTube Shorts Mini Bible lessons and encouragement.

Step 3: Challenge & Encourage (1 Minute)

Discipleship isn't passive—it's action-oriented. Push them toward their next step.

Challenge Questions:

- "What's one verse that hit you hard this week?"
- "How are you applying what God's teaching you?"
- "Who's one person you can encourage in their faith today?"

Example Call to Action:

"This week, read Colossians 3 and share your biggest takeaway. Tag me—I want to hear what God's showing you!"

Step 4: Multiply the Mission (1 Minute)

If discipleship stops with you, it's incomplete. Challenge them to disciple others.

How to Multiply Online:

- Ask them to share a Gospel truth with their followers.
- Start a group chat where they invite one friend.
- Encourage them to go live and share their testimony.
- **Example Challenge:** "You've got a voice. You've got a platform. Use it for eternity. Who's one person you can disciple today?"
