A Comfortable Christianity is a Compromised Christianity

We live in a time where Christianity has been sanitized, streamlined, and softened to fit the world's expectations. The edges have been dulled, the message has been repackaged, and the radical call to follow Christ has been replaced with something...safer.

But let's be clear: A Christianity that costs nothing is worth nothing.

The Hard Truth: Jesus Wasn't Safe

Jesus didn't come to make people comfortable. He didn't preach self-help, prosperity, or a gospel that bends to culture's demands. He came preaching **repentance**, **righteousness**, and an uncompromising call to take up our cross and follow Him (Luke 9:23).

Yet, many today are content with a Christianity that asks little and offends no one. We avoid confrontation. We downplay doctrine. We shrink back when the world tells us to be silent. **But silence isn't an option when eternity is on the line.**

What Are You Willing to Lose?

Here's the question every Christian must answer: **What are you willing to sacrifice for Christ?**

- Are you willing to lose comfort for the sake of the Gospel?
- Are you willing to lose approval from a world that despises truth?
- Are you willing to lose opportunities that require compromise?

The early church understood this. They were beaten, imprisoned, and martyred for the faith. And yet, in the West, we hesitate to share the Gospel because we might get an awkward look or a negative comment online.

It's Time to Stand Up

Christianity isn't passive. It's a battle cry. A mission. A daily, deliberate decision to stand for truth in a world drowning in lies.

- The culture says, "Follow your heart." Jesus says, "Deny yourself" (Matt. 16:24).
- The world says, "Live your truth." Jesus says, "I am the truth" (John 14:6).

• Society says, "Love is tolerance." Jesus says, "If you love Me, keep My commandments" (John 14:15).

We weren't saved to blend in—we were saved to stand out. **To be salt. To be light. To be unshakable.**

The Call to Action

If your faith costs you nothing, it will accomplish nothing. We need bold believers, not passive bystanders. We need disciples, not consumers.

- Speak truth even when it's unpopular.
