How to Share Your Faith in 5 Minutes Online

The Digital Mission Field is Wide Open

The world is scrolling—lost, searching, and in need of truth. You don't need a stage or a pulpit. You've got a phone, a keyboard, and a mission. The Gospel has never been more accessible, and in five minutes, you can plant a seed that shifts someone's eternity. Here's how to share Jesus online—boldly, creatively, and without compromise.

Step 1: Lead with Your Story (1 Minute)

People resonate with authenticity, not rehearsed sermons. Share a real, raw moment about how Jesus transformed your life.

O Tips:

- Keep it short—under 60 seconds if it's a video.
- Use an attention-grabbing opener (e.g., "I thought I had it all, but something was missing...")
- End with an invitation: "Has faith ever changed your life? Let's talk."

Example Post:

"For years, I chased success, approval, and distractions. But no matter how much I achieved, something was missing. Then I met Jesus—not a religion, but a real Savior. Everything changed. If you've ever felt empty, let's talk. #JesusChangedMyLife 1000LivesForChrist"

Step 2: Drop the Gospel (2 Minutes)

Keep it simple, direct, and clear—don't water it down.

- 📌 God's Design We were made for a relationship with God. (Genesis 1:27)
- 📌 Our Problem Sin separated us from Him. (Romans 3:23)
- richtist's Rescue Jesus took our place, died, and rose again. (Romans 5:8)
- ★ Our Response Repent, believe, and follow Him. (Romans 10:9)

Example Post:

"Ever wonder what Christianity is actually about? Here it is in 20 seconds:

- God created us for more.
- Sin broke everything.
- Jesus stepped in and took our place.
- Now, we choose—accept or reject His rescue.

Step 3: Start a Conversation (1 Minute)

The goal isn't to win arguments—it's to invite dialogue. Ask bold, thought-provoking questions.

Examples:

- "What do you think happens after we die?"
- "What's one thing that keeps you from believing in God?"
- "If Jesus really rose from the dead, what would that mean for you?"

Listen well. Respond with grace. Let the Holy Spirit do the heavy lifting.

Step 4: Offer Next Steps (1 Minute)

If someone is interested, don't leave them hanging—guide them to the Truth.

What to Share:

- A **Bible app link** (YouVersion, ESV Bible, or Logos)
- A trusted apologetics resource (Reasons to Believe, Reasonable Faith, or Wesley Huff)
- A personal invitation to message you or join an online Bible study

Example Response: "That's a great question! Check out this short video that explains more about Jesus. I'd love to hear your thoughts."

Final Charge: Just Show Up

Not every post will go viral. Not every comment will lead to conversion. But faithfulness wins in the long run. The Gospel is powerful—it just needs willing messengers. So go. Post boldly. Speak truth. Love radically. And trust God with the results.
