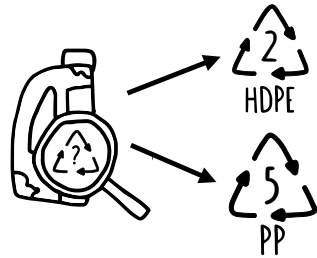


Cottontown Pilot Recycling (CPR) Project

Making a difference in Plastic Recycling !

The goal of this pilot is to collect as much clean, label free postconsumer #2 and #5 plastic as possible and understand what it will take to process it to make it ready to be made into new product! Our aim is to collect local plastic to create products for our local communities, creating local jobs.

1. How to identify different types of plastics



Find one of these symbols normally on the bottom of the container in *tiny tiny* print. If in doubt, throw it out!

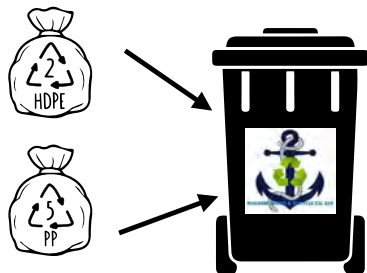
2. How to prepare the plastic for recycling



Peel** off the label if there is one, wash the container clean and put it in a bag labeled #2 or #5.

** The secret to peeling off the label is to apply a little heat with a hairdryer or such to make the glue budge.

3. Put the bags in the Anchor Shred and Recycle container

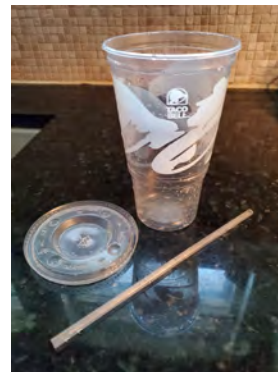
